PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 28A.600.477 requires each school district to provide to the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) a brief summary of their policies, procedures, programs, partnerships, vendors, and instructional and training materials prohibiting harassment, intimidation, and bullying (HIB) to be posted on OSPI's school safety center website. This information will be collected by survey.

Data collection will begin on March 1, 2023.

SURVEY DISTRIBUTION

On March 1, an email containing a link to the survey will be sent to each districts HIB Compliance Officer, as has been reported to OSPI. *The survey must be completed by March 29*.
