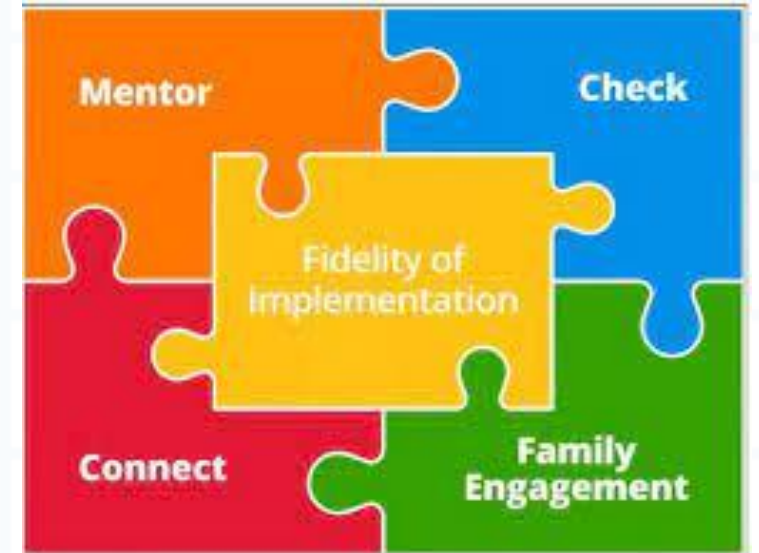
Intensive Supports: Wrap Around Support

Tier 3 includes supports such as:

- An identified staff of support from the school site to mentor and monitor scholars
- Frequent meetings and partnerships with parents and guardians
- Appropriate re-engagement supports in alignment with our district and state policies
- District level case management
- Continued monitoring and assessing of supports

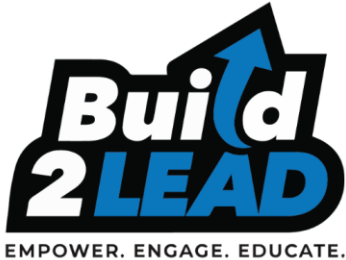
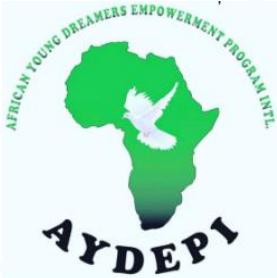
