



Career and Technical Education (CTE) 2017–2023 Program Approval Schedule

The purpose of the CTE Course and Program Approval processes is to make certain that all CTE courses:

- Ensure academic rigor;
- Align with the state’s education reform requirements and CTE Program Standards;
- Help address the skills gap of Washington’s economy; and
- Maintain strong relationships with local CTE advisory councils for the design and delivery of career and technical education.

Beginning in the 2017–18 school year, and annually thereafter, all approved CTE courses will be approved as part of the Program Approval process managed in the Education Data System (EDS). Program Approval review and submission windows have enforced due dates, and programs are approved on an annual cycle.
