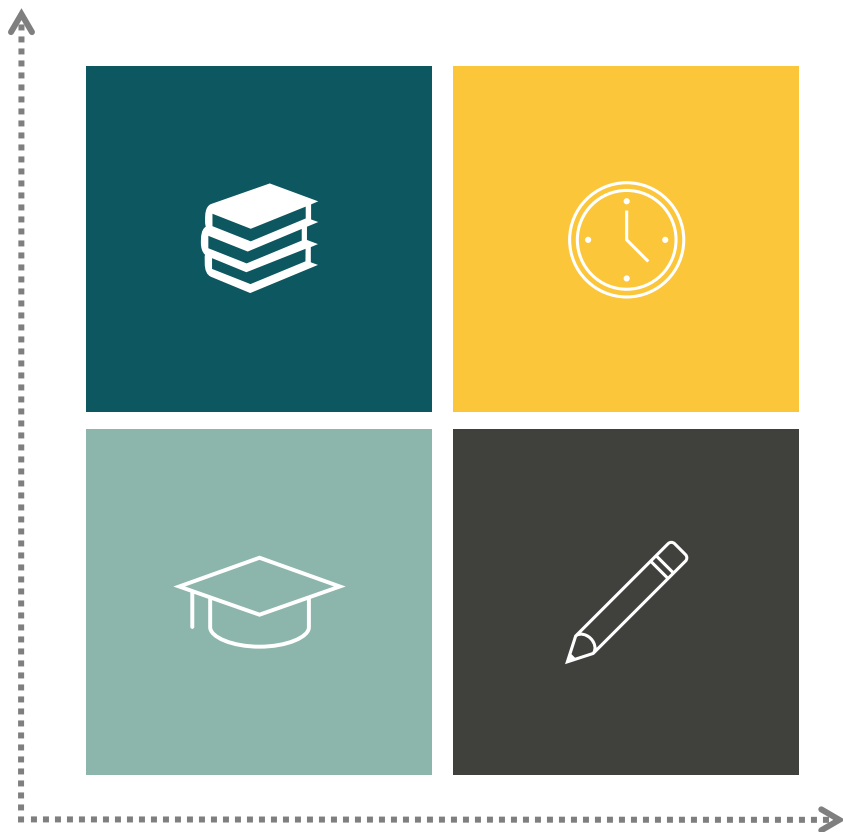


# OSPI Office of Native Education/Resources

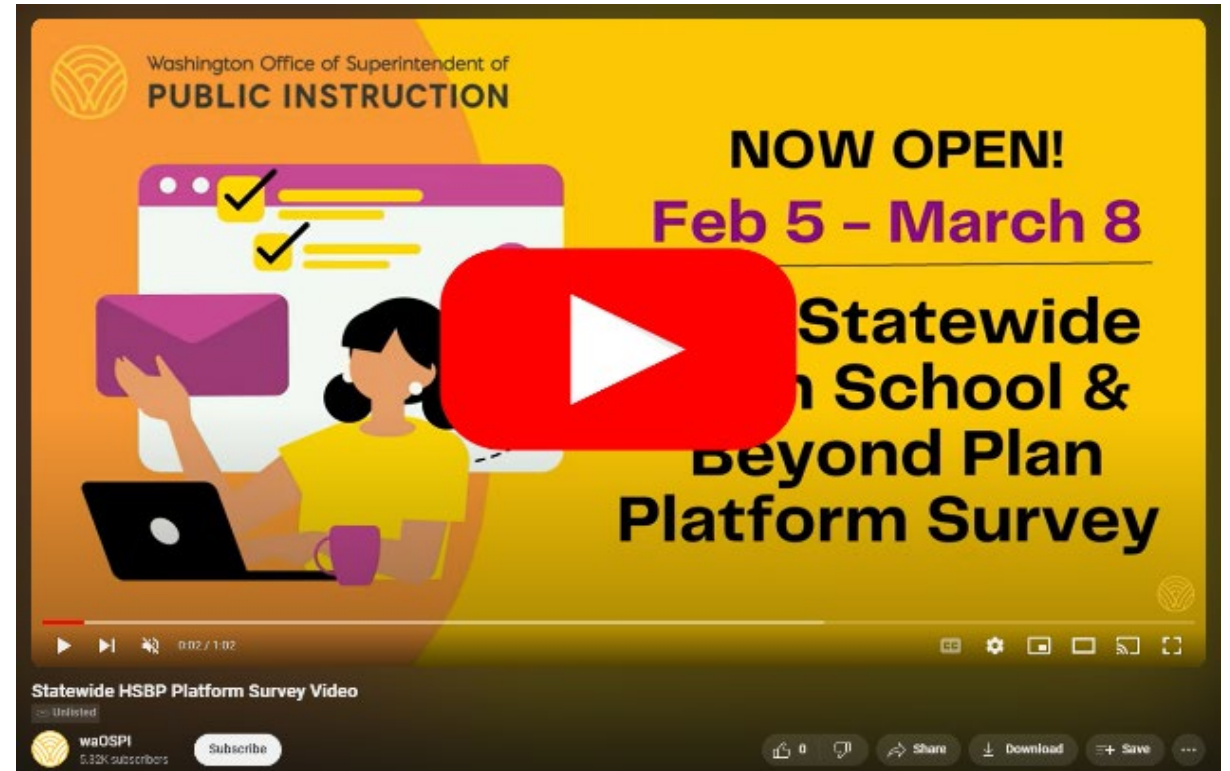

The table summarizes the current statewide equivalency course data as reported by school districts in the CEDARS system. There was an increase in the reported number of state equivalency courses offered by high schools and skill centers along with an increase of the number of students who received the option of equivalency credits.

# Selah School District CTE & Dual Language (DL) Program

- Selah's DL program is now up to 8th grade and moving to high school next year
- The DL program is 50-50 English/Spanish
  - Out of a student's 3 periods taught completely in Spanish, 2 are CTE: science & an elective (electives are ALL Viking Pathway driven and exploratory in nature)
- Soap box: "In Selah, we believe that *best fit* is what is most important for students regarding their future-- it is not about career and/or college, all students will have a career; the difference is how students get there and we go all in on supporting student exploration and guidance throughout their entire K-12 experience (we even have Pathway driven specialists in K-5!). CTE plays an essential role, and it's an integrated not isolated role."

# OSPI Releases Human-Centered AI Guidance for K-12 Public Schools

Uses of AI should always start with human inquiry and always end with human reflection, human insight, and human empowerment. Abbreviated as “Human AI Human” or “H→AI→H”, the guidance offers educators and students options to engage with AI responsibly, ethically, and safely.





# What AI *Is* and What It Is *Not*

## Generative AI is . . .

- A means to augment teaching and learning.
- Already embedded into many technologies, as is AI more broadly.
- Permeated with flaws such as algorithmic bias that must be considered when utilized.
- A product of companies led by teams of humans with their own values, agendas, limitations, bias, and organizational needs.
- An algorithm that enables users to generate new content based on a pre-trained Large Language Model.

## Generative AI is not . . .

- A replacement for student development
- Something that can plausibly be avoided or “turned off”
- A source of unquestionable information
- Produced in a vacuum free of societal influence
- A sentient being with untethered superhuman capabilities
- A replacement for highly qualified educators



# Human Centered Approach

- A ***human-centered AI learning environment*** is one that prioritizes the needs, abilities, and experiences of students, educators, and administrators
- Here are some ideas for supporting a human-centered AI learning environment:
  - Developing students' AI literacy
  - Ensuring ethical, equitable, and safe use of AI
  - Providing professional development
  - Applying human-centered design principles
  - Aligning AI solutions with the best practices and principles of learning

- Cheating/Plagiarism



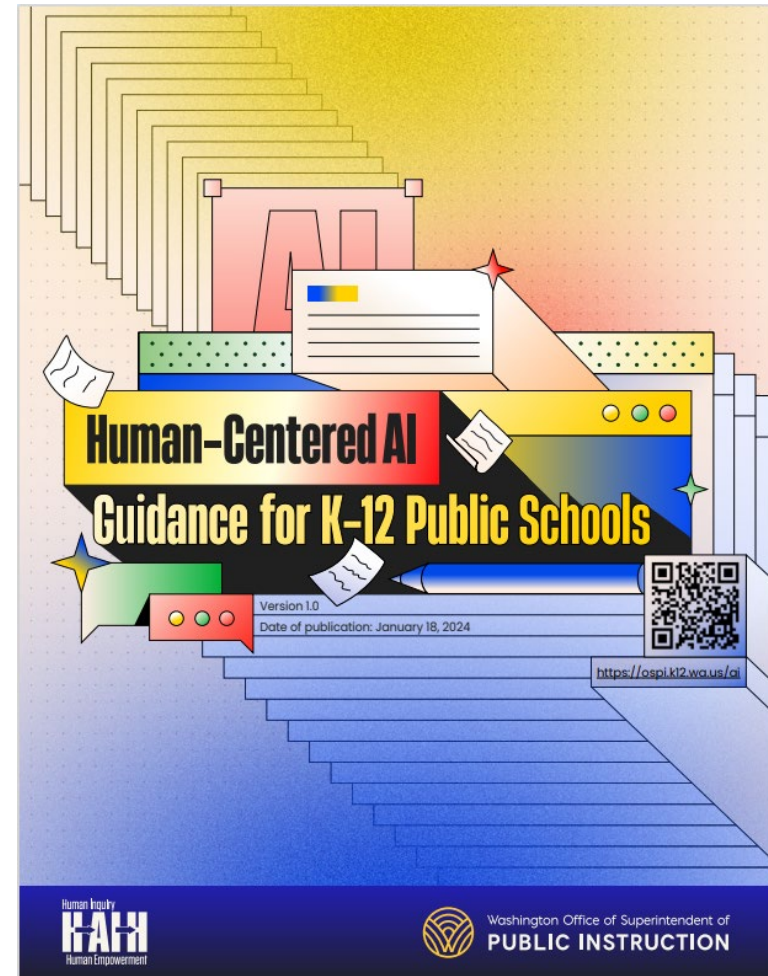
# Opportunities
