



## SAT<sup>®</sup> or ACT<sup>®</sup> Free Voucher Application College Admission Test Score Alternative Assessment

This free voucher application is for use by high school students who are registering to take the SAT<sup>®</sup> Reasoning Test (including writing), the ACT<sup>®</sup>, or the ACT Plus Writing<sup>®</sup> test as an “alternative assessment” to meet the Washington State high school Mathematics, Reading, and/or Writing standards for purposes of high school graduation and the Certificate of Academic Achievement.

**Eligibility Requirements:** To be eligible for a free voucher, the student must have taken the high school Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL) at least once and have not met the mathematics, reading, and/or writing standard(s) on the WASL or through a CAA Option. Students transferring into a Washington public school in the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade who are eligible to use the CAA Options are also eligible to use this voucher.

**One-time Use:** A student is eligible to register using a free voucher one-time for the SAT Reasoning Test<sup>®</sup>, the ACT<sup>®</sup>, or the ACT Plus Writing<sup>®</sup> test. Once the voucher has been submitted, it will be considered used even if the student does not take the test.

**Voucher Guidelines:** This voucher covers ONLY the cost of registration for taking these tests, including reports to the student’s high school and up to four college choices (if valid codes are provided on the mail-in paper registration form). Vouchers may not be used to pay for:

- Late/standby registration fees
- Additional college codes/reporting choices
- Test, date, or center change fees
- Online test preparation
- SAT Subject Tests<sup>®</sup>
- Test Information Release, Question-and-Answer Service
- Publications

**Procedures:** The student and his/her principal or designee must complete the information below and include this form with the **mail-in** paper registration form. Students may not use a voucher for payment when registering on the Internet or by phone.

*Include this with the completed SAT or ACT mail-in paper registration form.*

**Your registration and voucher must be postmarked by the regular registration deadline for your test date. If it is postmarked later, you must pay the late registration fee.**
