Name of Institution

1. We will submit a public release to the information media serving the area from which the adult care institution draws attendance announcing the availability of meals at no separate charge to eligible participants in attendance. The release will contain either or all weekly, monthly, or yearly income guidelines for both free and reduced-price meals.
2. We will include a statement that the program is available to eligible adults without regard to race, color, national origin, gender, age, or disability, on all publications, posters, and informational materials provided to the public. The statement will also include the information that any person who believes that he or she has been discriminated against in any U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA)-related activity should write immediately to the Secretary of Agriculture, Washington, DC 20250.
3. We will retain a copy of the public release sent to the information media in our permanent files, indicating names, addresses, and dates releases were mailed and send a copy to OSPI along with a copy of the cover letter sent to the media.
