### PURPOSE

Since the publication of the 2018–19 Enrollment Reporting Handbook found at [2018–19 Enrollment Reporting website](#) on July 9, 2018, a change was made.

### SUMMARY OF CHANGE

A clarification on early entrance exceptions for Kindergarten was made. Districts, charter schools, and tribal compact schools can enroll students who are under age 5 on September 1, 2018 in Kindergarten and claim them for state funding if they have adopted regulations that provide for individual exceptions to the uniform entry qualifications outlined in WAC [392-335-010](#).
