

## Examples of Running Start AAFTE Calculation and Potential Spring Quarter Adjustment

Example #1 – Student never exceeds 1.20 FTE in any month and therefore, will not exceed the 1.20 AAFTE. No adjustment required for spring quarter.

Example #2 – Student enrolled full time at high school and 1 three-credit college class for first semester/fall college quarter. For second semester/winter quarter, student enrolls in 1 one-hour high school class and 15 credits at the college. Available spring quarter FTE is reduced to 0.80 or 12 credits.

Example #3 – Student was not enrolled in college fall quarter. For the second semester/winter quarter, student switched to full time at the college and scaled back to 1 one-hour high school class. The student exceeded the 1.20 FTE for January due to the overlapping of the first semester and winter quarter. The student's available spring quarter credits are not reduced and the combined FTE is limited to 1.20.

Example #4 – Student increased college classes in winter quarter. The student exceeded the 1.20 FTE for January due to the overlapping of the first semester and winter quarter. Since the college FTE calculation is a 10-month average and there was no September college FTE, the student's available spring quarter credits do not require adjustment.

Example #5 – Student decreased college classes in the winter quarter and never exceeded the 1.20 FTE limitation in January. No adjustment required for spring quarter.

Example #6 – This example illustrates what is not allowed. Student was not enrolled in college fall quarter and took 4 one-hour classes at the high school. For the second semester/winter quarter, student switched to full time at the college and scaled back to 1 one-hour high school class. A Running Start student's FTE cannot exceed 1.20 FTE for any month other than January even if the AAFTE may remain at or below 1.20 AAFTE. In this example, the student is limited to 15 spring quarter credits.
