Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 392-144-160 requires each school district to annually evaluate each authorized school bus driver for continuing compliance with the provisions of chapter 392-144 WAC. Please check off each box verifying completion and compliance:

- Each authorized school bus driver has completed the current year's inservice training prior to November 1, 2011, as required by WAC 392-144-020(5).
- Each authorized school bus driver's medical examiners certificate expiration date, first aid expiration date, and driver's license expiration date has been updated in compliance with OSPI procedures.
- Each authorized school bus driver has completed an updated disclosure statement as required in WAC 392-144-102(4).
- Each authorized school bus driver's current and original abstract has been obtained from the Department of Licensing and the driving record is in compliance with WAC 392-144-103(2), (3), and (5).
- Each authorized school bus driver currently driving meets the requirements of WAC 392-144-102(5)(a)-(d).

PLEASE NOTE: If an authorized school bus driver is on an extended personal leave of absence or a medical condition related leave of absence, the driver is required to meet all the requirements of an authorized school bus driver prior to resuming duties as a school bus driver transporting students.

The minimum requirements for all school bus drivers have been updated in the database, and an evaluation has been conducted on each authorized school bus driver as required above.
