

## Verification Tool 3: 3% Focused Sampling Worksheet

To determine the number of applications that must be verified, follow the steps below.

Local Education Agencies (LEAs) with a verification non-response of **20% or greater must** use the 3% Focused Sampling method (*Tool 3*).

Local Education Agencies (LEAs) with a verification non-response of **less than 20%** may choose to use the 3% Focused Sampling method (*Tool 3*).

3,000 Applications (whichever is less)

### Sample Selection

Error prone applications in the required amount to verify must be selected. Error prone applications are those applications with income listed within \$1,200 yearly; \$100 monthly; \$50 twice a month; \$46 every two weeks and \$23 weekly of the free and reduced-price eligibility levels.

If there are not enough error prone applications to meet the sample size requirement, randomly select additional applications from both income and case number applications until the required sample size is reached.
