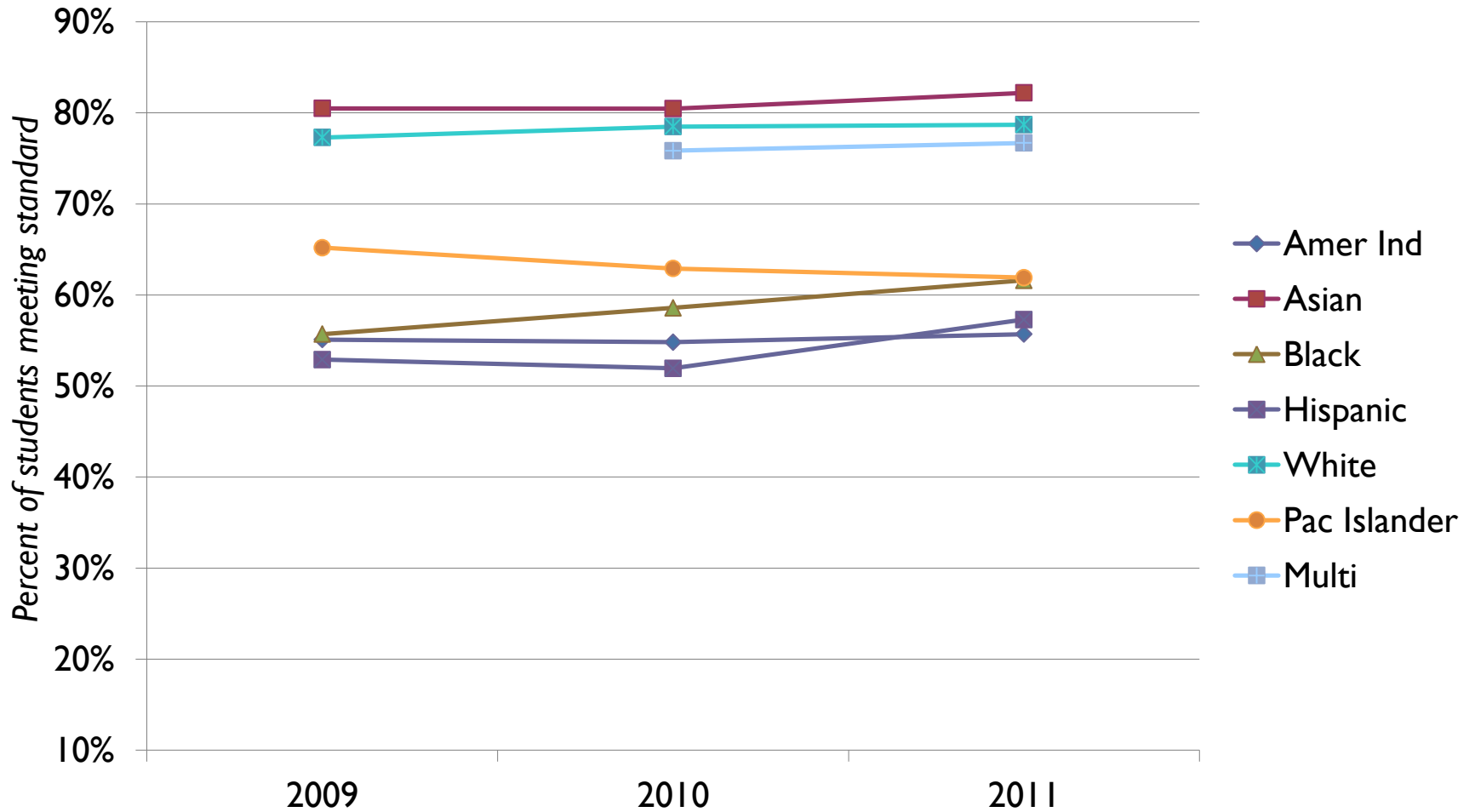

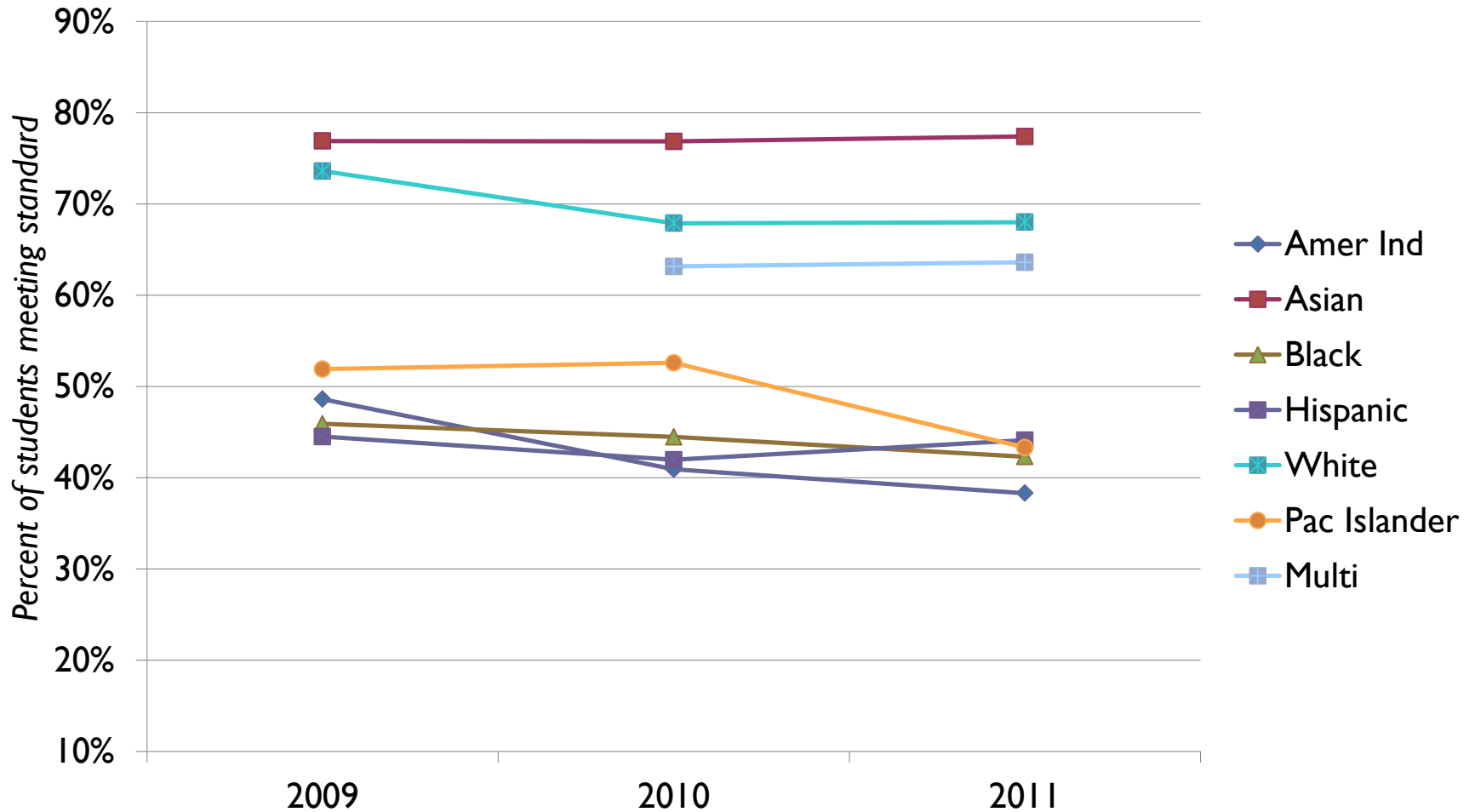

Reading, 3rd grade, 2009-11



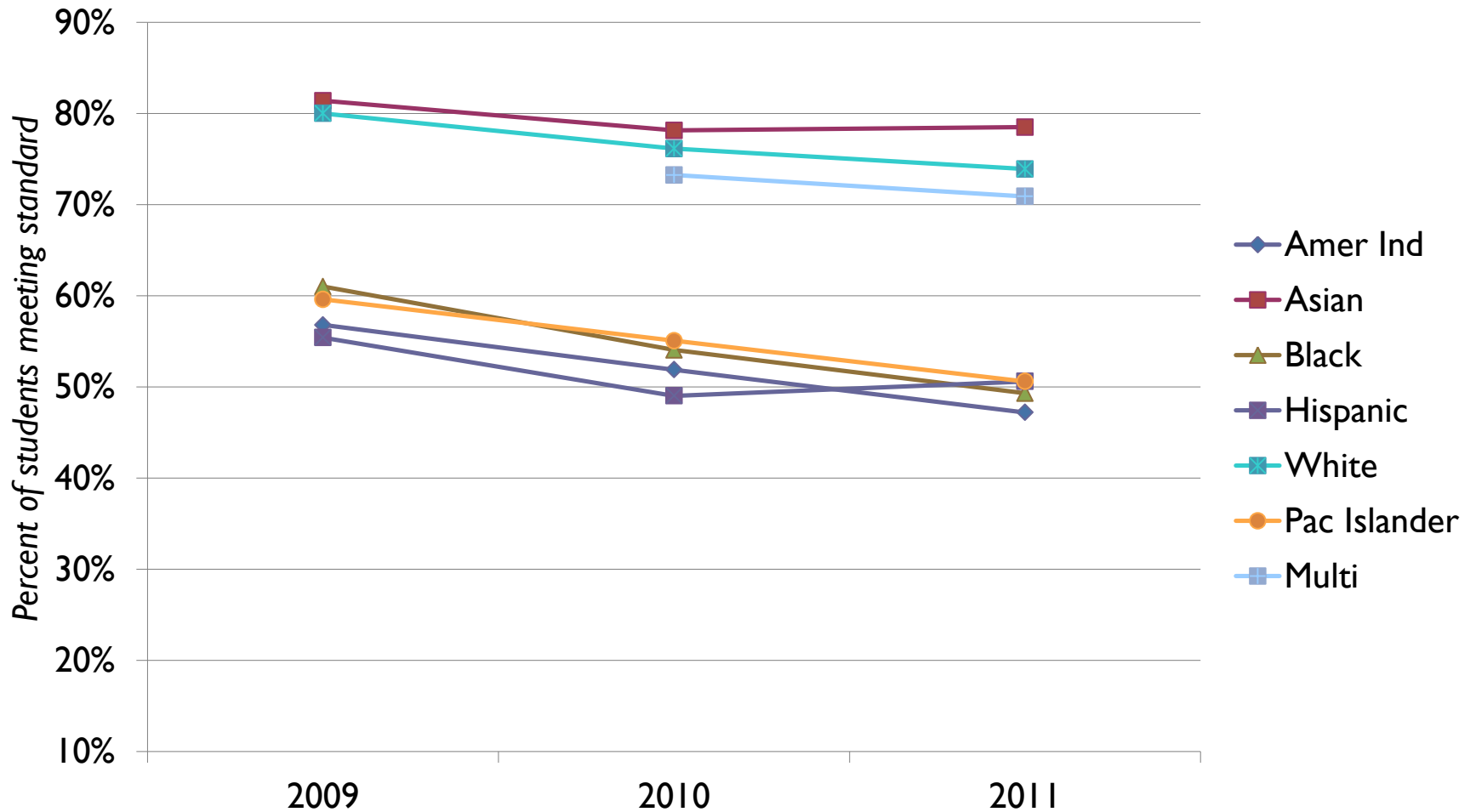

Math, 3rd grade, 2009-11



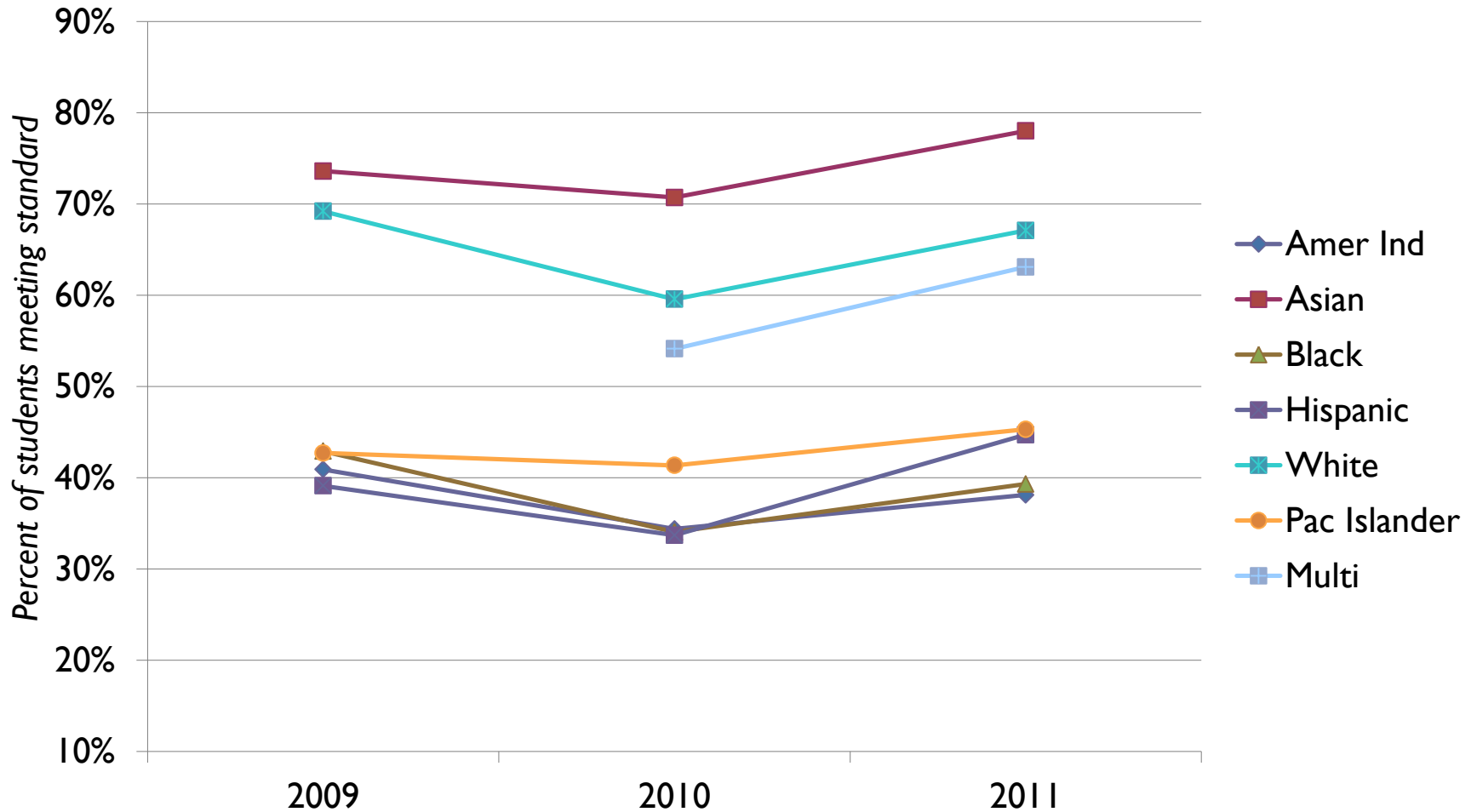

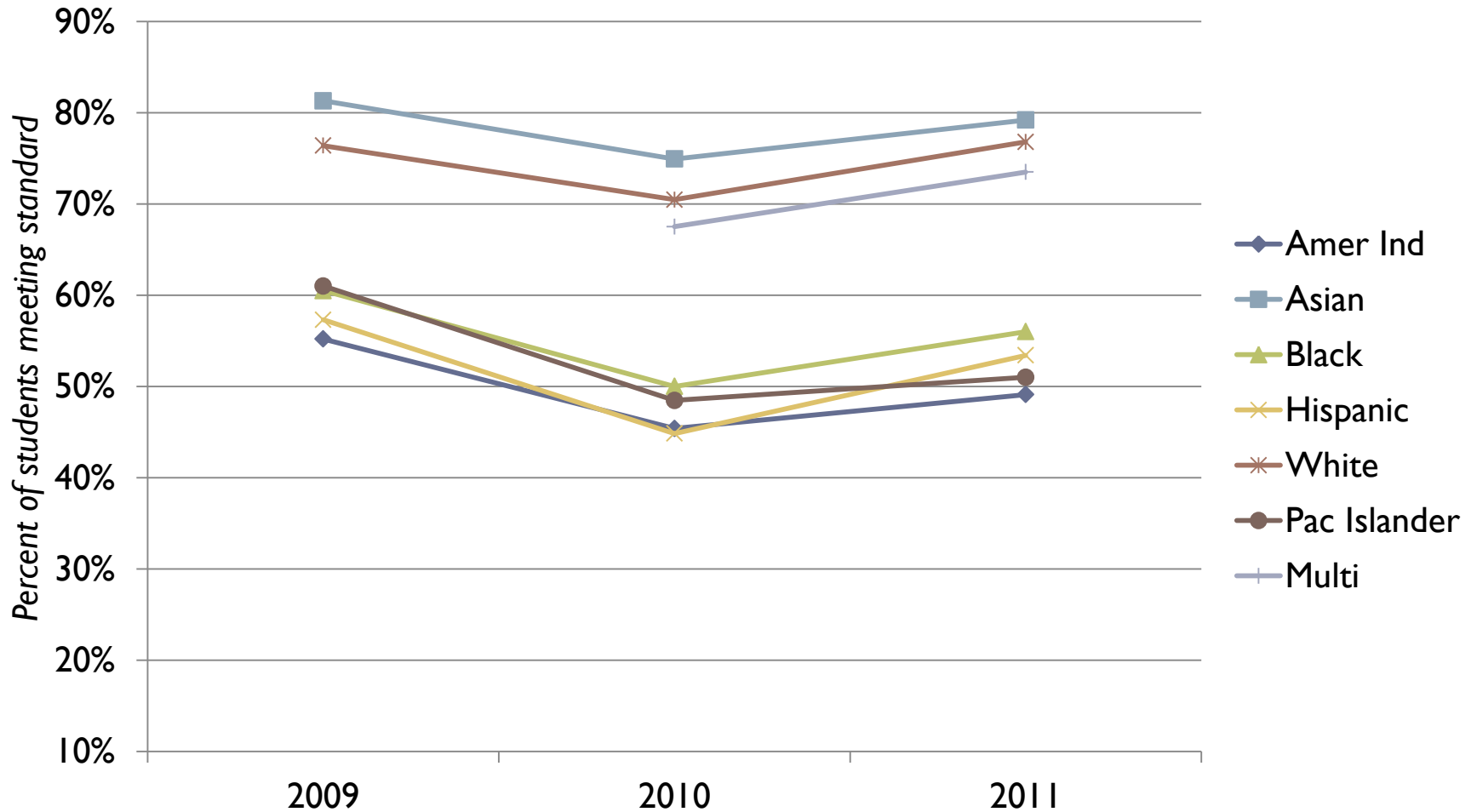

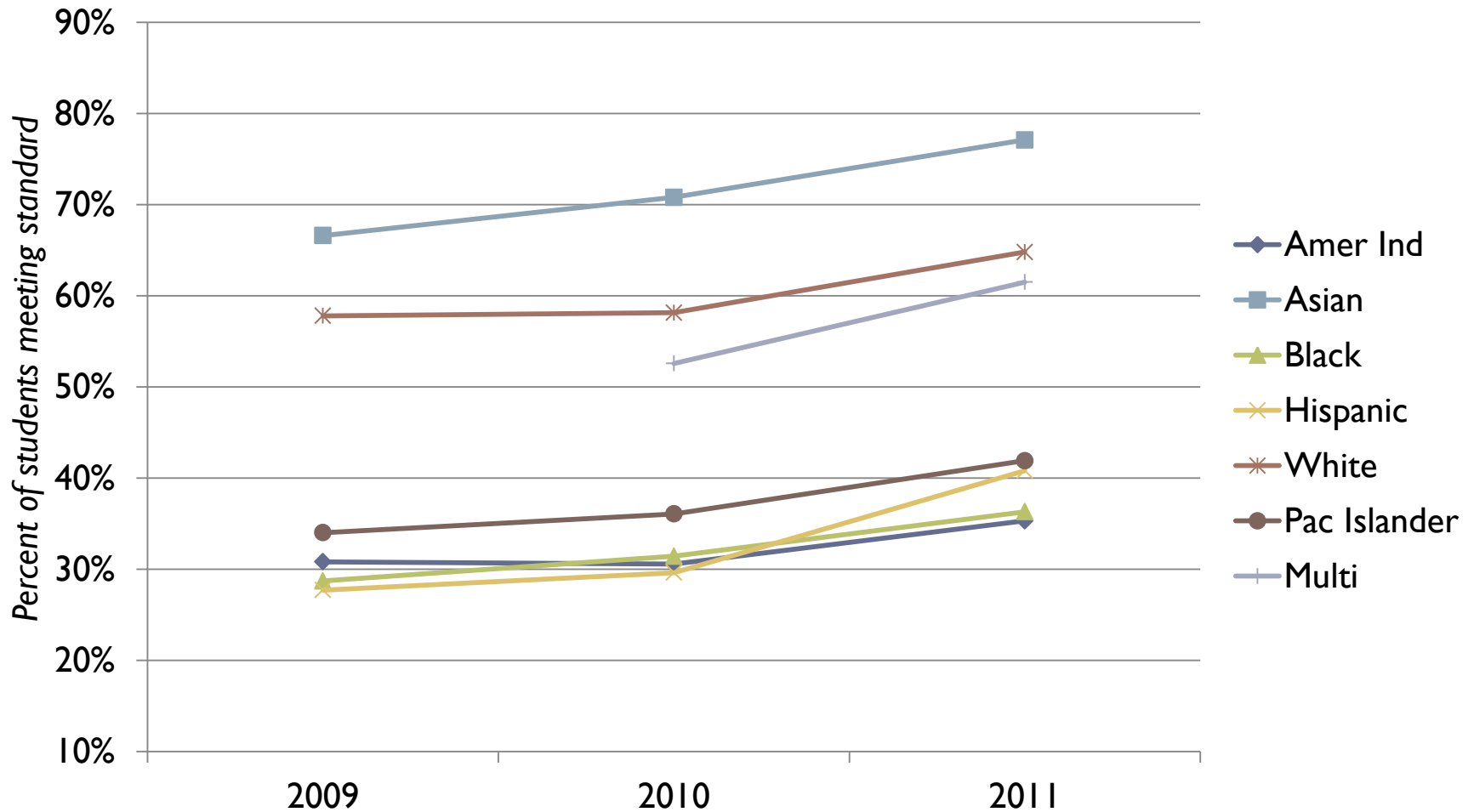

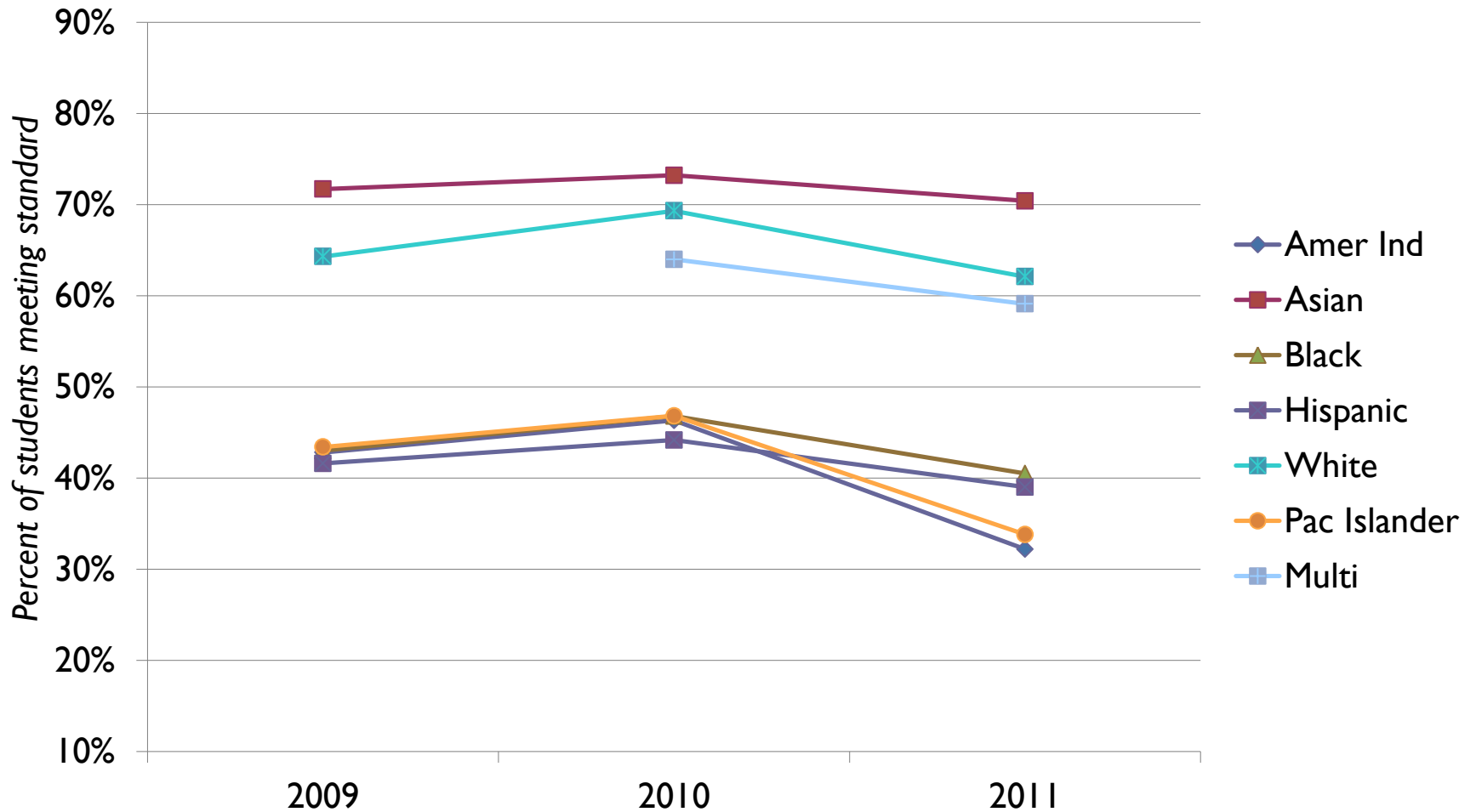

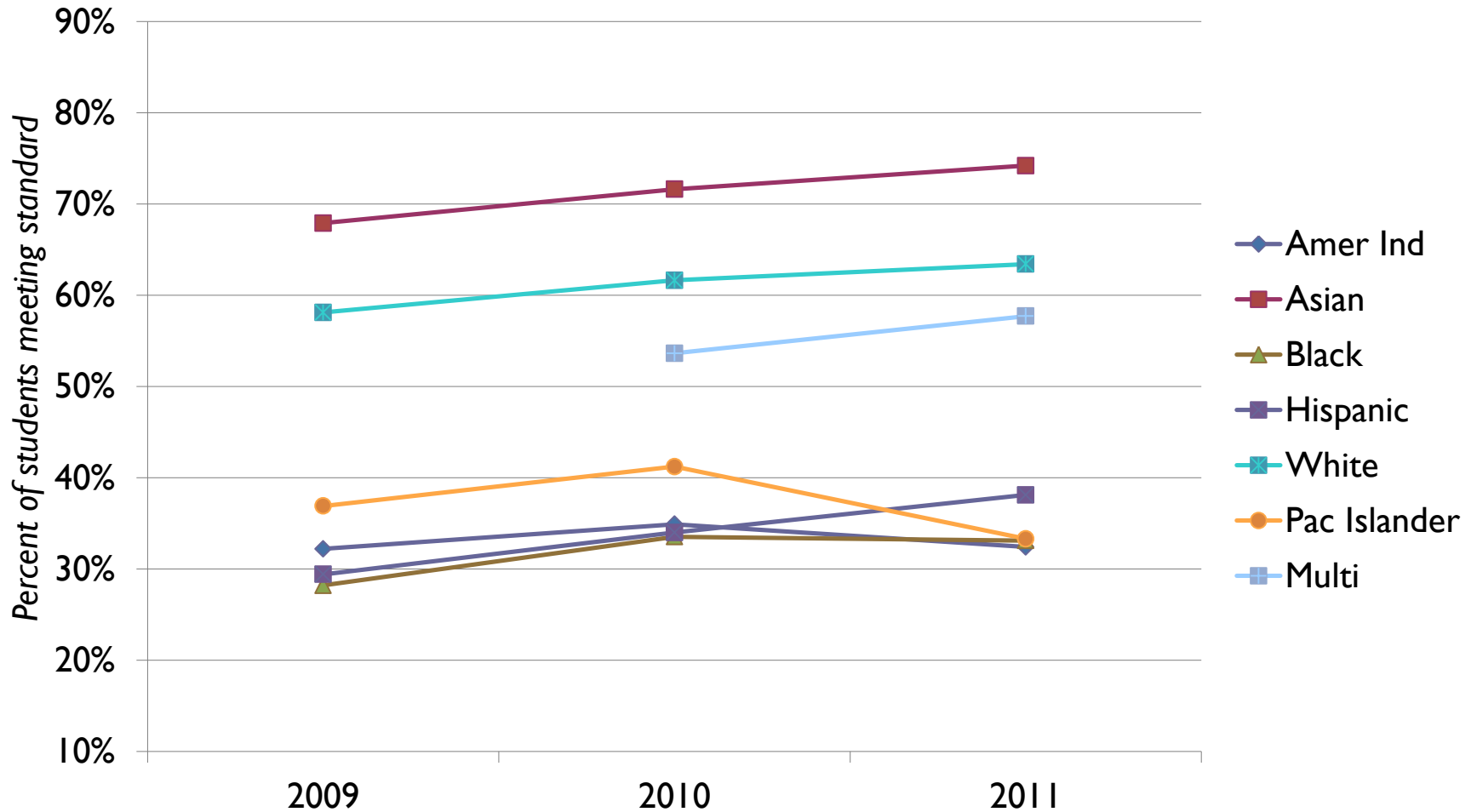

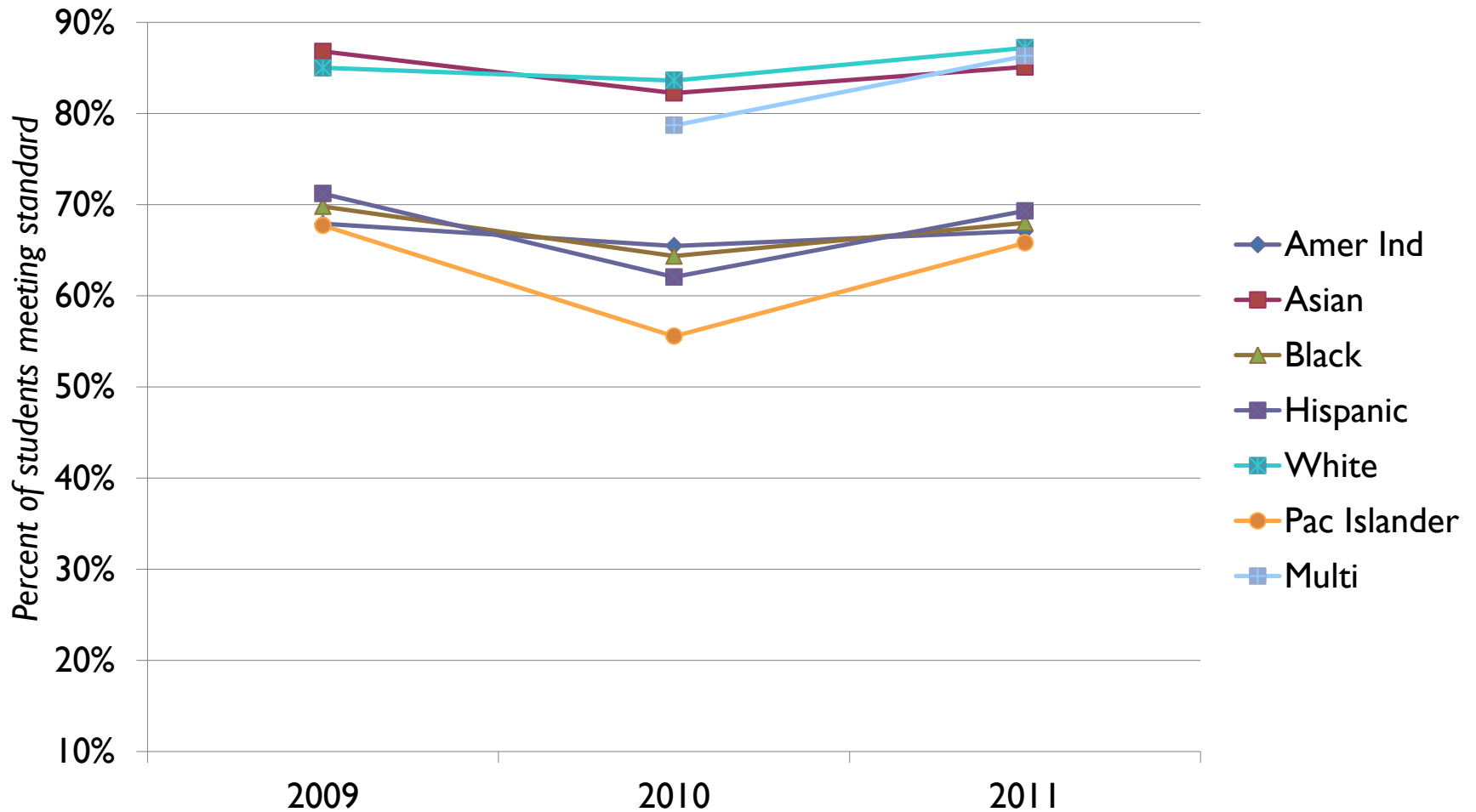

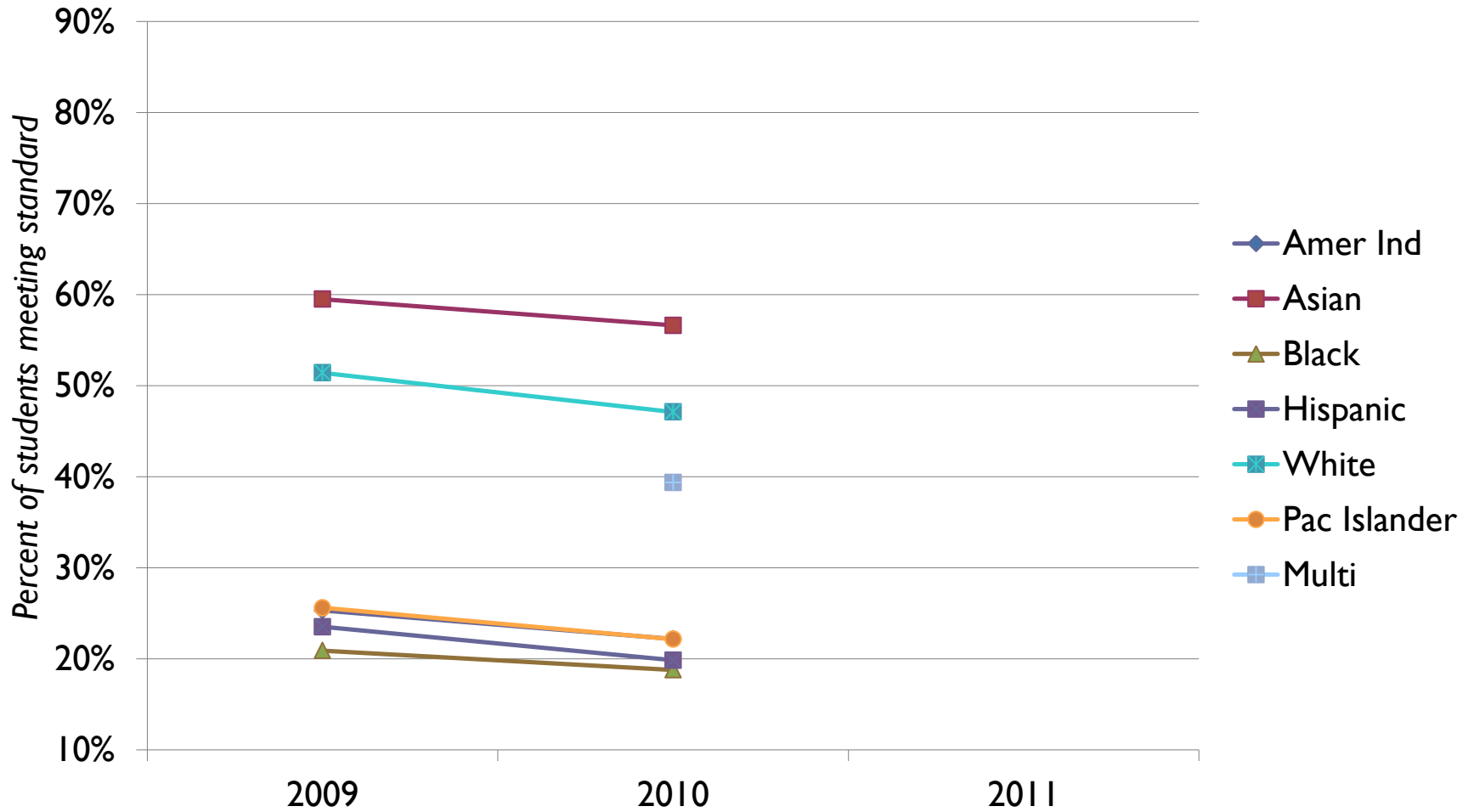
HSPE results, by ethnic group

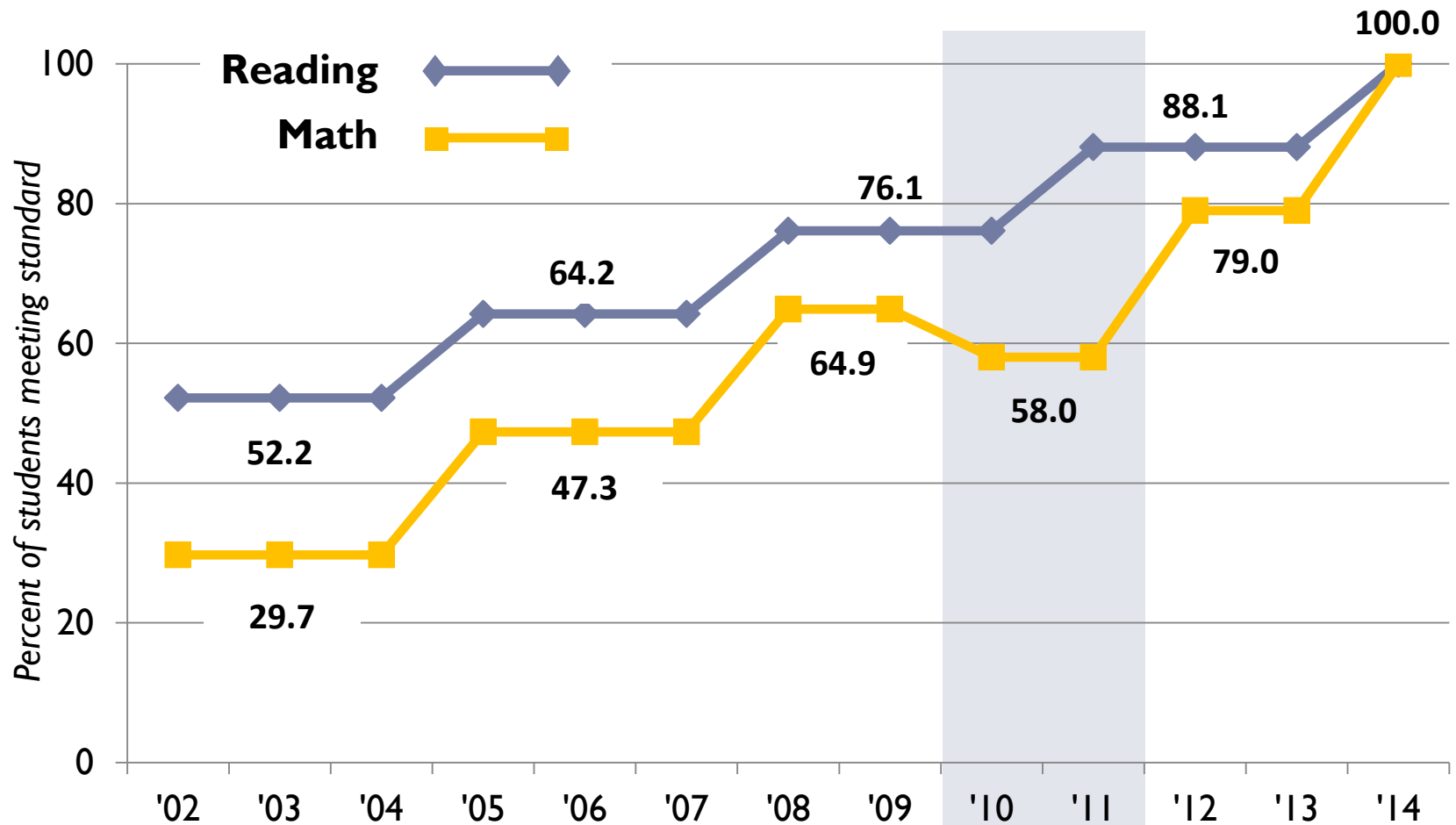




Adequate Yearly Progress

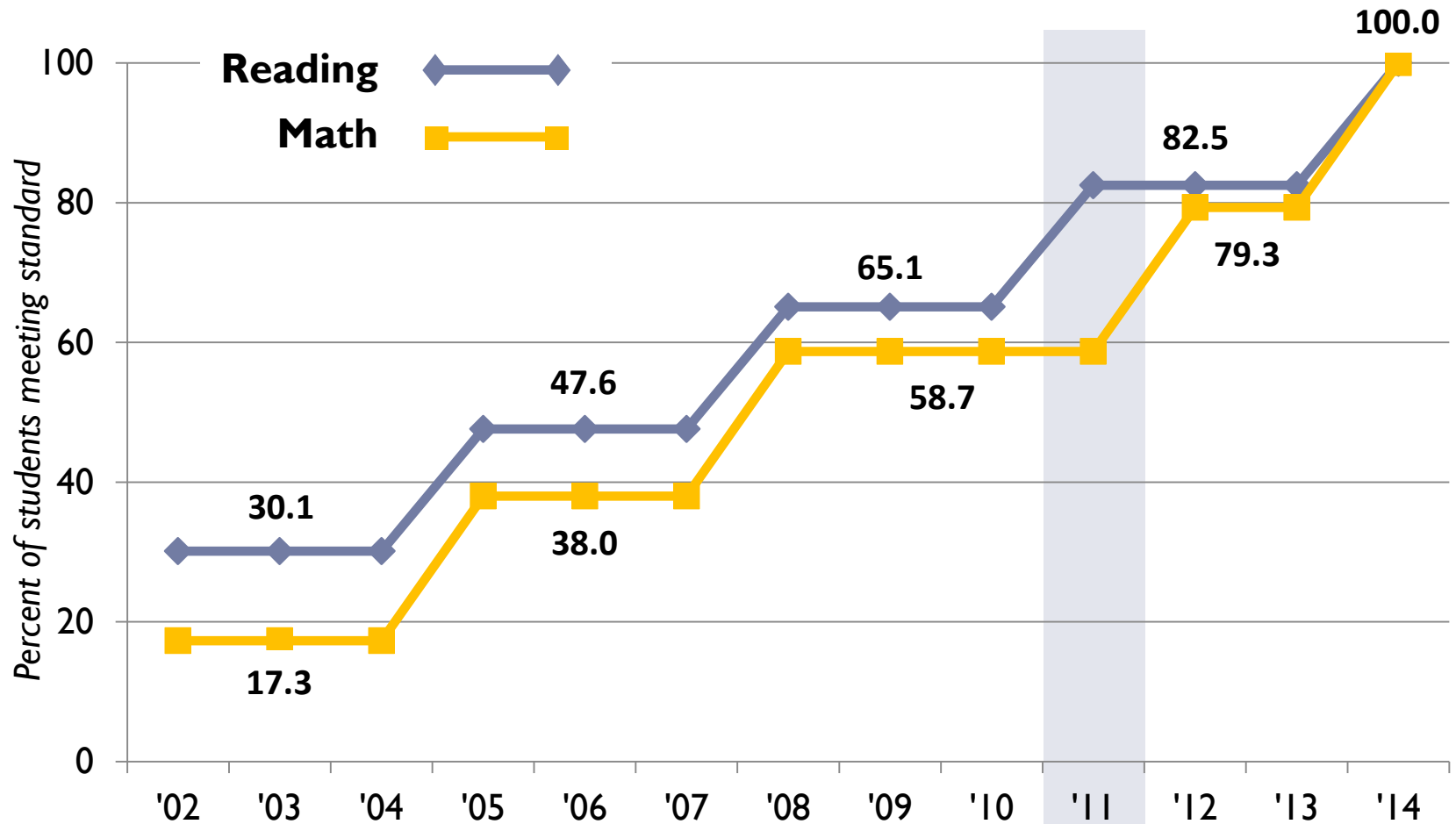
ESEA requirements

Adequate Yearly Progress facts: Schools

- ▶ **265:** Schools that missed only in one cell
- ▶ **630:** High schools (i.e., schools that have 10th graders) in which took reading and/or math tests.
- ▶ **388:** High schools that met math columns in both proficiency and participation.
- ▶ **242:** High schools that did not meet either math proficiency column or math participation column.
- ▶ **35:** Schools that exited improvement.

Adequate Yearly Progress facts: Districts

- ▶ **223:** Districts that did not meet AYP (out of 295 districts)
- ▶ **113:** Districts in improvement (34 in Step 1, 79 in Step 2)
