The Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) will align the work to support and implement the requirements of the State Fiscal Stabilization Fund (SFSF) Program related to teacher and principal evaluation data collection with [Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 6696](#) (ESSSB 6696) as passed by the state legislature, March 2010.

Project Timeline

- Teacher and principal 4-tiered evaluation system
 - Development 2010-11 school year
 - Pilot 2011-12 school year
 - Implementation 2012-13 school year
 - Full implementation by the beginning of the 2013-14 school year

Activities

- Established executive steering committee with membership representing various stakeholders – April 2010
- Completed school district and school application process – May 2010
- Select pilot schools and districts – June 2010
- Provide support system for selected pilot school districts and schools – Ongoing
- Align data collection requirements and communicate information and timelines to school districts – Ongoing
