QUICK FACTS: TITLE I, PART C: MIGRANT EDUCATION

ESSA keeps the focus on equity of education for migrant students.

RETAINING AND REENGAGING MIGRANT STUDENTS

Requires states to address dropout students, developing structures and programs to encourage migrant students to reenroll in school.

MEASURABLE GOALS

ESSA focuses on incorporating tangible goals into migrant education plans.

BETTER PRIORITIES TO HELP MIGRATORY STUDENTS

- Assist states in supporting comprehensive educational programs, during the school year and intersession periods.
- Ensure students aren't penalized by academic disparities between states.
- Allow students to receive full and appropriate opportunities to meet academic standards.
- Help students overcome educational disruption, cultural and language barriers, social isolation, health problems, and other factors inhibiting success.
- Provide students with the benefits of systemic reforms.
