**District Demographics:**

Olympia School District serves approximately 2800 students from birth through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. Of that total, 35 are under age 3, about 250 are preschoolers and the rest are school age. The district's enrollment is 77% white, 5% Hispanic, 9% Asian, 3% Black, and 1% American Indian. The percentage of students qualifying for free or reduced price lunch ranges from 8% in a few elementary schools to close to 50% in two elementary schools, with a district-wide average of 22%. The district wide percentage of students receiving special education services is 13% and about 2% of students are eligible for ELL support. The schools with higher percentages of low income students also have an enrollment of between 13% and 16% students whose primary language is not English, with another 7-10% listed as bilingual.
