Deadlines & Extensions

- Monday, April 5, 2010 is the deadline. Submit your district technology plan through the online SIP Tool.

Extension Period

- If you can't make the deadline, file an extension.
- Mail your extension form to OSPI by Monday, April 5, 2010.
- Choose an extension date carefully — you risk losing the E-rate discount and EETT eligibility.

School Board Letter of Approval

- District school board must approve your technology plan first.
- We recommend that you present your technology plan to the board in February 2010.

SIP Tool Submission & Changes

- Updates to the online SIP Tool streamline the technology planning process.
- Changes go live late November.
- Need access? Contact your District Data Security Manager. Ask for **District SIP read/write** privileges.

New Technology-Related Goal

- Technology proficiencies of administrators, teachers and teacher-librarians.
- Develop a goal and progress strategies to move from *have not reached the basic level* proficiency to *basic level* to at the *proficient level*.

New Narrative Section

- High-level overview that explains how the building(s) in your district are addressing the need to integrate technology into teaching and learning, as part of their school improvement plan(s).
- You can include your building-level plan(s), but they're optional.
