COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby permanently revoke the Washington Education Certificate, No. 112346B, of Norman Standley, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Norman Standley was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 112346B, on June 9, 1961. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. On February 21, 2007, the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), within OSPI, became aware that Norman Standley had been convicted of a felony offense included with WAC 180-86-013(1).

3. On May 18, 2005, an Information and Affidavit of Probable Cause Determination was filed in Whatcom County Superior Court charging Norman Standley with one count of Child Molestation in the 2nd Degree, RCW 9A.44.086; Whatcom County Superior Court Cause #05-1-00729-2. The female victim was Mr. Standley's granddaughter.

4. On December 7, 2005, Mr. Standley signed a Statement of Defendant on Plea of guilty to Sex Offense. Mr. Standley admits that between February 1, 2000 and June 30, 2000, he had sexual contact with a female, who was at least 12 years old but less than 14 years old and not married to Mr. Standley; Whatcom County Superior Court Cause #05-1-00729-2.

5. On December 8, 2005, Mr. Standley was found guilty of the felony crime of Child Molestation 2nd Degree, RCW 9A.44.086. Mr. Standley was sentenced to: DNA testing; 20 months confinement in the custody of the county jail or the Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC); eligibility for Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SOSA); the sentence was suspended and Mr. Standley was placed in community custody care with DOC for a period of three (3) years; as a condition of suspended sentence, Mr. Standley was to undergo and successfully complete a sex offender treatment program for a period of 36 months; as a condition of receiving a suspended sentence, Mr. Standley was to serve six (6) months total confinement; registration with the sheriff of the county of his residence as a sex offender; and other standard sentencing provisions. The Court also found that a motor vehicle was used in the commission of the crime and the court clerk was directed to notify Washington State Department of Licensing

(DOL) of the conviction and DOL must revoke Mr. Standley's driver's license, RCW 46.20.285; Whatcom County Superior Court Cause #05-1-00729-2.

6. Norman Standley has pleaded guilty or been convicted of a crime identified in Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 28A.410.090(3). Such a plea or conviction authorizes OSPI to permanently revoke the Education Certificate.

7. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Norman Standley and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 112346B, of Norman Standley, should be revoked, as provided for in WAC 181-86-075.

3. Norman Standley has violated WAC 181-86-013, WAC 181-86-014, and/or RCW 28A.410.090.
