ORDER OF REVOCATION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby revoke the Washington education certificate, No. 376765D, of Johnni Hanson, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Johnni Hanson was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 376765D, on May 3, 2000. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Johnni Hanson was employed by the Stanwood-Camano School District as a teacher and coach.
3. On September 20, 2002 the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), within OSPI, received a complaint letter from Dr. Jean Shumate, Ed. D, Superintendent of the Stanwood-

Camano School District, alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Johnni Hanson. This letter was accompanied by a previous letter of complaint dated August 26, 2002.

4. On March 18, 2002 Kevin Planbeck, Director of Career & Technical Education, sent a follow-up memo to Johnni Hanson regarding a meeting they had about Johnni Hanson allowing another employee unauthorized use of his scan access code. This is verified in a statement from the teacher involved.

5. On March 18, 2002, Jim Piccolo, Vice Principal, issued a letter of direction to Johnni Hanson instructing him to maintain and render appropriate records regarding daily attendance.

6. On March 25, 2002, Mr. Gary Vegar, Principal, issued Johnni Hanson a written reprimand for unprofessional behavior – sleeping during instructional time.

7. On April 22, 2002 Jim Piccolo, Vice Principal and Athletic Director issued a letter of direction to Johnni Hanson for driving his personal car to a track meet in Wenatchee on March 23, 2002, while transporting a student. The memo states that Johnnie Hanson arrived at the track meet late and left after approximately 40 minutes. Mr. Hanson's response was he had the student drive him to the track meet and left early because he was ill. In his statement the student said Johnni Hanson asked him to accompany him to the track meet in Wenatchee and that the two of

them smoked crack cocaine before they left Mr. Hanson's house and again on the way to the track meet.

8. On May 3, 2002 Gary Vegar issued a written reprimand to Johnni Hanson for mishandling public/private fund raising money (missing money and unpaid bills) and conflicting interest in violation of school district policy 5223 section A.

9. March 25, 2002 James Piccolo wrote a memorandum to Dr. Jean Shumate recommending non-renewal of Johnni Hanson's teaching contract with Stanwood High School for unsatisfactory performance. On April 26, 2002, Dr. Shumate issued a letter of cause for the non-renewal of Johnnie Hanson's employment contract with the Stanwood-Camano School District.

10. May 3, 2002, Johnnie Hanson submitted his letter of resignation from his teaching and coaching positions in the Stanwood School District #401 effectively immediately.

11. On August 26, 2002 Dr. Shumate issued a no trespass notice to Johnni Hanson prohibiting him from attending District-sponsored events and prohibiting him from coming on Stanwood-Camano School District property.

12. Students from the Stanwood-Camano School District reported that Johnni Hanson provided them with drugs and made sexual advances toward them.

13. On January 27, 2003 the Snohomish County Prosecuting Attorney's office filed criminal charges against Johnni Hanson for Distribution of a controlled substance to a person under age 18, Delivery of a controlled substance, and Communication with a minor for immoral purposes.

14. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Johnni Hanson and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence, that the Washington education certificate, No. 376765D, of Johnni Hanson, should be revoked as provided for in WAC 180-86-075.

3. Johnni Hanson has violated WAC 180-87-055, WAC 180-87-060, WAC 180-87-080, WAC 180-87-085, RCW 28A.410.090, WAC 180-86-013, and WAC 180-86-014.
