COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby permanently revoke the Washington Education Certificate, No. 386231E, of Brad Goings, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Brad Goings was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 386231E, on April 23, 2001. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Brad Goings was employed by the Aberdeen School District.
3. On November 24, 2008, the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Aberdeen School District, alleging a

lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Brad Goings.

4. From the fall of 2007 through the fall of 2008, Brad Goings had inappropriate communications with K.C.; E.S.; and K.P., all three, female students at Aberdeen High School.

5. In June of 2008, Brad Goings engaged in sexual intercourse with E. S., a female student at Aberdeen High School.

6. On September 10, 2008, Brad Goings was placed on Administrative Leave by Superintendent Martin Kay.

7. On November 13, 2008, an Information and Motion and Declaration for Order For Warrant of Arrest were filed in Grays Harbor County Superior Court, Cause Number 08-1-540-5, charging Brad Goings with: 1 count of Sexual Misconduct with a Minor in the First Degree, RCW 9A.44.093(1)(b), and 3 counts of Communication with a Minor for Immoral Purposes, RCW 9.68A.090(2).

8. On November 20, 2008, Brad Goings was issued a Notice of Probable Cause for Discharge from the Aberdeen School District.

9. On January 28, 2009, Brad Goings entered into a settlement agreement with the Aberdeen School District, and tendered his resignation.

10. On April 2, 2009, an Amended Information was filed in Grays Harbor County Superior Court, Cause Number 08-1-540-5, Charging Brad Goings with: 2 counts of Assault in the Third Degree, RCW 9A.36.031(1)(d)

11. On April 17, 2009, Brad Goings signed a Statement of Defendant on Plea of Guilty, in which he pleaded guilty to the charges listed in the Amended Information filed in Grays Harbor County Superior Court, Cause Number: 08-1-540-5.

12. On April 17, 2009, a Felony Judgment and Sentence was filed in Grays Harbor County Superior Court, Cause Number: 08-1-540-5. Brad Goings was found guilty of two (2) counts of Assault in the Third Degree, both class C felonies. Brad Goings was sentenced to eight (8) months of confinement in the Grays Harbor County Jail, and will be eligible to apply for the Work Release Program after four (4) months of confinement.

13. On April 23, 2009, OPP sent a letter to the attorney for Brad Goings and to Brad Goings requesting the opportunity to provide a statement to OPP about the charges, requesting a response no later than May 8, 2009. As of May 14, 2009, OPP has not received a statement from Brad Goings, or his attorney.

14. Brad Goings has pleaded guilty or been convicted of a crime identified in Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 28A.410.090(3). Such a plea or conviction authorizes OSPI to permanently revoke the Education Certificate of Brad Goings.

15. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Brad Goings and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 386231E, of Brad Goings, should be permanently revoked, as provided for in WAC 181-86-075.

3. Brad Goings has violated WAC 181-87-060, WAC 181-87-080, WAC 181-86-013, WAC 181-86-014, RCW 28A.410.090, and/or RCW 9A.36.031.


