ORDER OF REVOCATION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby revoke the Washington education certificate, No. 266747E, of Douglas Moore, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Douglas Moore was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 266747E, on July 1, 1985. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Douglas Moore was employed by the Renton School District.
3. On September 16, 2002, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter alleging a lack of good moral character and personal fitness of Douglas Moore.

4. On July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2001, Douglas Moore received an Agreed Order of Reprimand from OSPI for using school district equipment during classes at the Ephrata School District to view inappropriate images of nude women.

5. On December 20, 2001, Douglas Moore received an Adult Sexual Behavior Problem Evaluation by Robert Staunton PhD. Dr. Staunton recommended that Douglas Moore;

- A. Undergo a two to three year adult sexual offender treatment program.
- B. Have no contact with anyone under eighteen years or age until permitted by his sex offender therapist.
- C. Complete a disclosure and polygraph examination every four months.
- D. Be mandated to complete sex offender treatment program.
- E. Be mandated to complete an aftercare program.
- F. Be prohibited from possession pornographic materials.

Dr. Staunton categorized Douglas Moore as a moderate to high sexual re-offense risk. Douglas Moore has not provided evidence of compliance with these recommendations.

During the evaluation, Douglas Moore admitted to having an intimate relationship with a female student while employed in a School District out-of-state.

6. Douglas Moore had an inappropriate, intimate relationship with a female student who attended his out-of-state school, as evidenced by her sworn statement.

7. Douglas Moore engaged in inappropriate touching and conversation with a female student during the 2000-2001 school year, as shown in her sworn statement.

7. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Douglas Moore and over the subject matter of this action.
  
2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence, that the Washington education certificate, No: 266747E, of Douglas Moore, should be revoked as provided for in WAC 180-86-075.

3. Douglas Moore has violated WAC 180-87.
