COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby revoke the Washington Education Certificate, No. 417522J, of Kenneth Stacy, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Kenneth Stacy was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 417522J, on November 1, 2005. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. On December 28, 2005, the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), within OSPI, received information through the National Association of State Directors of Teacher Education and Certification database, that the state of Oregon had taken action against Mr. Stacy's Oregon Teaching Certificate



3. On October 26, 2004, the Multnomah County, Oregon District Attorney's Office filed an indictment charging Mr. Stacy with fifteen (15) counts of Aggravated Theft in the First Degree, (Oregon Revised Statute 164.057), five (5) counts of Theft in the First Degree (Oregon Revised Statute 164.055), and twenty (20) counts of Forgery 1st Degree (Oregon Revised Statute 165.013); Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County No. 0410 35804.

4. On February 18, 2005, Mr. Stacy signed a Petition to Plead Guilty and Waiver of Jury Trial. Mr. Stacy pleaded guilty to 5 counts of Aggravated Theft 1st Degree and 2 counts of Forgery 1st Degree.

5. On April 27, 2005, Mr. Stacy was sentenced to: supervised probation for a period of five (5) years; thirteen (13) months incarceration under work release; joint restitution, with his wife, in the amount of \$237,493.30.

6. On October 11, 2005, the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County found Mr. Stacy in violation of his probation. All work release time from the April 27, 2005 Sentence and Judgment was converted to 390 days of jail time.

7. On October 16, 2005, Mr. Stacy signed a Stipulation of Facts, Surrender and Order of Revocation with the State of Oregon Teacher Standard's and Practices Commission (TSPC). On November 7, 2005, The State of Oregon TSPC accepted the surrender of Mr. Stacy's Standard Teaching License and revoked said license.

8. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Kenneth Stacy and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence, that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 417522J, of Kenneth Stacy, should be revoked as provided for in WAC 181-86-075.

3. Kenneth Stacy has violated WAC 181-87, RCW 28A.410.090, WAC 181-86-013, WAC and/or 181-86-014.


