COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby revoke the Washington Education Certificate, No. 418984A, of Amy Wilson, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Amy E. Wilson was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 418984A, on July 26, 2004. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Amy E. Wilson was employed as a certified teacher in the State of Oregon.
3. On June 30, 2008, the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), within OSPI, received information through the National Association of State Directors of Teacher Education and Certification (NASDTEC) database, that the state of Oregon had taken action against Amy Wilson's, Oregon Teaching Certificate.

4. On February 11, 2008, the Oregon Teacher Standards and Practices Commission issued a Default Order of Revocation of Right to Apply For Licensure to Amy E. Wilson, listing nine Findings of Fact. The Finding of Facts stated that during the 2003/2004 school year, Amy Wilson failed to use professional judgment; was involved in sexual harassment; failed to maintain appropriate professional student-teacher relationships, and failed to report to a supervisor when she had reason to believe that a student was or may have been becoming romantically attached to her.

5. On July 7, 2008, OPP sent Amy Wilson a certified Mail, Notice of Complaint to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] St., Vancouver, WA 98[REDACTED]. The Notice was returned to OPP with notation added "Moved" and "Not deliverable as addressed, unable to forward."

6. On July 18, 2008, OPP sent a second certified mail, Notice of Complaint to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Ave, Vancouver WA 98[REDACTED]. It was returned with "No Amy Wilson at this address try below", with the written address of: P.O. Box [REDACTED], [REDACTED], WA 98[REDACTED].

7. On August 19, 2008, OPP sent a certified mail, Notice of Complaint to Amy Wilson at: P.O. Box [REDACTED], [REDACTED], WA 98[REDACTED]. The mailing was returned to OPP marked "Refused, wrong Amy Wilson."

8. On September 25, 2008, OPP sent a certified mail, Notice of Complaint to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] St. [REDACTED], OR 97[REDACTED]. The mailing was returned to OPP marked "Unclaimed."

9. On October 27, 2008, OPP sent a certified mail of the Notice of Complaint to the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office for Civil Service of the Notice of Complaint to Amy E. Wilson at [REDACTED] St. [REDACTED], OR 97[REDACTED].

10. On November 6, 2008, the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office served Amy E. Wilson, the Notice of Complaint.

11. On November 6, 2008, Amy E. Wilson left a voice mail with OPP stating that her certificate was expired in Washington State. With the use of profanity, Amy Wilson said that she would send her certificate if we wanted, followed by the statement that OPP should never attempt to contact her again, and she had no desire to ever teach in our state again.

12. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Amy Wilson and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence, that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 418984A, of Amy Wilson, should be revoked as provided for in WAC 181-86-075.

3. Amy Wilson has violated RCW 28A.410.090, WAC 181-86-013, WAC 180-86-014, and/or WAC 181-87-060


