FINAL ORDER
OF SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby suspend the Washington Education Certificate No. 187524D, of Charles Trujillo for twelve (12) months based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Charles Trujillo was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 187524D, on December 13, 1971. That certificate currently remains valid.

2. Charles Trujillo was employed by Highline School District.

3. On December 12, 2008, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from John Welsh, the Superintendent of Highline School District, alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 181-87, by Charles Trujillo.

4. On November 13, 2008, while working as a guest teacher at Choice Academy, Charles Trujillo was in possession of a magazine, Bustie Beauties; which contained sexually explicit images.

5. On November 13, 2008, Charles Trujillo opened the magazine, Bustie Beauties, and K.K., a 14 year old male student, observed sexually explicit images in the magazine.

6. On November 14, 2008, Charles Trujillo was terminated by Highline School District.

7. On January 20, 2009, OPP received a letter from Charles Trujillo, explaining the events of November 13, 2008.

8. On May 21, 2009, Charles Trujillo participated in an interview with an OPP investigator.

9. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Charles Trujillo and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 187524D, of Charles Trujillo, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 181-86-070.

3. Charles Trujillo has violated: RCW 28A.410.090, WAC 181-87-060, WAC 181-86-013 and/or WAC 181-86-014.


ORDER

It has been thirty days since the Proposed Order of Suspension was received. The appeal time period has passed. It is hereby ordered that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 187524D, of Charles Trujillo is suspended.

Reinstatement shall require submission of a new application, including Character and Fitness Supplement, provided by OPP, and having Charles Trujillo's fingerprints checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP). Reinstatement shall be also contingent upon Charles Trujillo's fingerprint background check returning with no criminal convictions that are listed in WAC 181-86-013, RCW 28A.410.090, and/or any felony convictions.
