AGREED ORDER
OF SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and John Bayne, that the Washington education certificate, No.144259R, of John Bayne, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. John Bayne was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 144259R, August 19, 1966. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. John Bayne was employed by the Port Angeles School District.
3. On April 24, 2002, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Port Angeles School District alleging a violation

of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by John Bayne. Except for the complaint filed with the Office of Professional Practices concerning this matter, no other complaints concerning Mr. Bayne have been filed with OSPI.

4. John Bayne inappropriately used School District computer equipment during 2001.
5. Mr. Bayne remained an employee of the Port Angeles School District through the remainder of the 2001-2002 school year.
6. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over John Bayne and over the subject matter of this action.
2. OSPI has met its evidentiary burden by proving that the Washington education certificate, No.144259R, of John Bayne, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.
3. Based upon Mr. Bayne's inappropriate use of District computer equipment, a suspension should issue pursuant to WAC 180-86 and 180-87.

ORDER

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered and agreed that the Washington education certificate, No. 144259R, of John Bayne, be suspended for sixty (60) days, beginning on September 1, 2002, and ending on October 30, 2002.

Reinstatement will be automatic at the end of this period.
