COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Daniel G. Collins, that the Washington Education Certificate, No.319450C, of Daniel G. Collins, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Daniel G. Collins was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 319450C, on August 31, 1997. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Daniel G. Collins was employed by the Mary Walker School District.
3. On June 18, 2003, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from Richard Conley, Superintendent of the Mary Walker School District, alleging a lack

of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Daniel G. Collins.

4. Daniel Collins viewed inappropriate internet sites on school district equipment during spring, 2003.

5. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Daniel G. Collins and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington Education Certificate, No. 319450C, of Daniel G. Collins, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.

3. Daniel G. Collins has violated WAC 180-86 and WAC 180-87.


ORDER

Reinstatement shall require submission of a new application to OPP by Daniel Collins.


