AGREED ORDER
OF SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Marc Eilers, that the Washington education certificate, No.332313F, of Marc Eilers, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Marc Eilers was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 332313F, on July 28, 1994. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Marc Eilers was employed by the Monroe School District.

3. On December 10, 2002, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Monroe School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Marc Eilers.

4. Marc Eilers used school district computer equipment inappropriately during the ~~2002-~~²⁰⁰¹⁻²⁰⁰² ~~2003~~ school year.

5. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Marc Eilers, and over the subject matter of this action.
 2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington education certificate, No. 332313F, of Marc Eilers, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.
 3. Marc Eilers has violated WAC 180-87 and WAC 180-86-013/014.
