AGREED ORDER
OF SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Russell Kendall, that the Washington Education Certificate, No.303643A, of Russell Kendall, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Russell Kendall was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 303643A, on January 8, 1991. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Russell Kendall was employed by the Grandview School District.

3. On May 18, 2005, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Grandview School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Russell Kendall.

4. Over the 2003-2004 and 2004-2005 school years, Mr. Kendall accessed inappropriate sites on his school-district computer.

5. Mr. Kendall resigned from the Grandview School District on 6/13/05.

6. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Russell Kendall and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington Education Certificate, No.303643A, of Russell Kendall, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.

3. Russell Kendall has violated: RCW 28A.410.090, WAC 180-87-060, WAC 180-86-013, and WAC 180-86-014.

ORDER

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered and agreed that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 303643A, of Russell Kendall, be suspended for four (4) months effective August 15, 2005.

Reinstatement shall require submission of a new application, provided by OPP and having Mr. Kendall's fingerprints be checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP).
