COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Marcus Rieke, that the Washington education certificate, No.272986A, of Marcus Rieke, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Marcus Rieke was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 272986A, on July 1, 1986. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Marcus Rieke was employed by the Federal Way School District.

3. On August 7, 2001, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Federal Way School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness by Marcus Rieke.

4. On June 25, 2001, Marcus Rieke was terminated by the Federal Way School District based upon an investigation of his accessing inappropriate internet sites on his school office computer between January and June 2001.

5. On September 25, 2001, Marcus Rieke sent a letter to the Office of Professional Practices in which he takes responsibility for accessing inappropriate websites. He requests that this letter be considered as his sworn statement.

6. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Marcus Rieke and over the subject matter of this action.
2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington education certificate, No. 272986A, of Marcus Rieke, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.
3. Marcus Rieke has violated WAC 180-87.

ORDER

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered and agreed that the Washington education certificate, No. 272986A, of Marcus Rieke, be suspended for a minimum of sixty (60) days from the date of entry of this Order, to be automatically reinstated at the end of the suspension period.
