COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and STACY MARIE WILSON, that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 362004D, of STACY MARIE WILSON, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Stacy Marie Wilson was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 362004D, on July 8, 1998. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Stacy Marie Wilson was employed by the Sumner School District.



3. On April 11, 2005, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Sumner School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, and/or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 181-87, and (WAC) 181-86-013 by Stacy Marie Wilson.

4. On March 17, 2005, Stacy Marie Wilson was approached on school grounds by D.D., a sixteen-year-old high school student, and prior sixth grade student of Ms. Wilson's. He asked Ms. Wilson to buy him beer. Ms. Wilson agreed and drove to a local grocery store, purchased a six-pack of beer and returned to the school where she gave the beer to the student, D.D.

5. Student D.D. was found later that night under the influence of alcohol by the Sumner Police Department. He was treated by a medic unit and released to the custody of his mother.

6. On March 18, 2005, Stacy Marie Wilson was placed on administrative leave.

7. The Sumner Police Department investigated the case (0500674), and interviewed Ms. Wilson, who at first denied buying the beer for the student, but then in a signed statement, admitted to purchasing a six-pack of beer and giving it to the student, D.D.

8. Stacy Marie Wilson entered into a settlement agreement with the Sumner School District on March 23, 2005, resigning her employment with the district.

9. On March 25, 2005, Stacy Marie Wilson was charged in Sumner Municipal Court with violating RCW 66.44.270, "Furnishing Liquor to Minors", a Gross Misdemeanor.

10. On April 7, 2005, Stacy Marie Wilson entered herself into individual psychotherapy with Judith A. DeFelice, Ph.D. a Licensed Clinical Psychologist, WA # 1595.

11. On May 11, 2005, Stacy Marie Wilson plead guilty to the charge of "Furnishing Liquor to Minors" in Sumner Municipal Court, and was sentenced to 365 days of jail time, with all but 1 day suspended, and fined \$5,000 with all but \$250 suspended, plus additional court cost.

12. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Stacy Marie Wilson and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington Education Certificate, No. 362004D, of Stacy Marie Wilson, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 181-86-070.

3. Stacy Marie Wilson has violated WAC 181-86-013, 181-86-014, 181-87-085, 181-87-060 and RCW 28A.410.090.

ORDER


THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered and agreed that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 362004D, of Stacy Marie Wilson, be suspended for twenty-four months from the date of entry of this Order.

Reinstatement will require successful completion of regular, individual psychotherapy as required by her psychologist, and Stacy Marie Wilson will provide an evaluation that she is safe to return to the classroom to teach. Reinstatement shall also require submission of a new application, provided by OPP, and having Stacy Marie Wilson's fingerprints checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP). In addition, Stacy Marie Wilson, if requested, will sign consent forms authorizing OPP to have access to all records pertaining to her treatment as it relates to her educational duties, and to discuss any, and all treatment undertaken with the providers administering treatment as it relates to her educational duties. The cost of conformance to all reinstatement requirements will be the responsibility of Stacy Marie Wilson.


