AGREED ORDER
OF SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Ann Shoddy, that the Washington Education Certificate, No.353527A, of Ann Shoddy, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

1. Ann Shoddy was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 353572A, on July 3, 1997. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Ann Shoddy was employed by the Kelso School District.
3. On February 20, 2003, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the superintendent of the Kelso School District alleging a lack of good

moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Ann Shoddy.

4. During the 2002-2003 school year, Ann Shoddy failed to properly grade student course work.

5. During the 2002-2003 school year, Ann Shoddy was tardy for classes on numerous occasions. These actions resulted in a conference from Principal Don Iverson on November 8, 2002, a letter of district expectations from Principal Don Iverson on November 27, 2002, conference summary from Assistant Principal Cindy Cromwell, dated December 4, 2002, a letter of instruction from Principal Don Iverson dated December 5, 2002, and a letter of reprimand from Principal Don Iverson on January 9, 2003.

6. On December 5, 2002, Ann Shoddy sent a junior high school student to check on the classroom of another teacher.

7. The Kelso School District did not renew Ann Shoddy's contract for the 2003-2004 school year.

8. On November 18, 2004, Ann Shoddy received a deferred prosecution for a Driving while Under the Influence of intoxicants (DUI) charge in Cowlitz County District Court. She is currently in treatment, and is actively participating in a recovery program.

9. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Ann Shoddy and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 353572A, of Ann Shoddy, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.

3. Ann Shoddy has violated (pick applicable chapters: WAC 180-87-060, WAC 180-86-013, and WAC 180 86-014.

ORDER



Reinstatement shall require submission of a new application, provided by OPP and having Ann Shoddy's fingerprints be checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP).




