

3. On October 30, 2006, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Peninsula School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 181-87, by Ron Spieker.

4. During the 2005-2006 and the first part of the 2006-2007 school year, Mr. Spieker used his school district assigned computer to access and view sexually explicit images.

5. On or about September 21, 2006, the Peninsula School District discovered that Ron Spieker was using his school computer to gain access to multiple web sites with sexually explicit images. While the sexually explicit material was viewed on the school's computer, it was not accessed or observed by any student. There were sexually explicit image sites, which contained the word "teen" in the internet address, visited but there is no indication of any child pornography sites accessed.

6. On September 21, 2006, Mr. Spieker was placed on administrative leave.

7. During an interview with Peninsula School District officials on September 22, 2006, Mr. Spieker admitted to accessing and viewing sexually explicit images on his school district assigned computer.

8. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

ORDER


THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered and agreed that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 16664g, of Ron Spieker, be suspended for four (4) months from the date of entry of this Order.

Reinstatement will require successful completion of the following stipulations:

- (1) successful completion of a psychological evaluation which validates Ron Spieker's ability to have unsupervised access to children, by an evaluator mutually agreed upon by the Office of Professional Practices (OPP) and Ron Spieker;
 - (2) that Ron Spieker provide written consent for OSPI to release documents to the evaluator for purposes of completing an evaluation and course of treatment;
 - (3) that Ron Spieker follows and completes any and all treatment recommended in the evaluation;
 - (4) that Ron Spieker provides a release authorizing OPP to have access to records of any and all evaluations and any and all subsequent treatment undertaken;
 - (5) and that the cost of conformance to all reinstatement requirements will be the responsibility of Ron Spieker.
- Reinstatement shall also require submission of a new application, provided by OPP and having Ron Spieker's fingerprints be checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP).
