COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Don Garnand, that the Washington education certificate, No.324905R, of Don Garnand, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

### FINDING OF FACTS

1. Don Garnand was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 324905R, on December 4, 1993. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Don Garnand was employed by the Highline School District.

3. On August 15, 2002, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Highline School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, by Don Garnand.

4. Don Garnand used School District equipment to access inappropriate internet sites during the spring term of 2002.

5. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Don Garnand and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington education certificate, No. 324905R, of Don Garnand, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.

3. Don Garnand has violated WAC 180-87.


Reinstatement will be automatic at the end of the suspension period.
