COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Robert Hugill, that the Washington education certificate, No.303975G, of Robert Hugill, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Robert Hugill was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 303975G, on January 24, 1991. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Robert Hugill was employed by the Tacoma School District.

3. On March 12, 2001, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Tacoma School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Robert Hugill.
4. On March 14, 2001, Robert Hugill tested positive for cocaine use during school hours.
5. On October 30, 2002, Robert Hugill was sentenced to serve twelve months in the Pierce County jail based upon guilty findings for Theft in the First Degree and for Forgery.
6. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Robert Hugill and over the subject matter of this action.
2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington education certificate, No. 303975G of Robert Hugill, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.
3. Robert Hugill has violated WAC 180-87-055, WAC 180-86-013, and WAC 180-86-014.

AGREED ORDER OF SUSPENSION

ORDER

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered and agreed that the Washington education certificate, No. 303975G, of Robert Hugill, be suspended for twenty-four (24) months, from December 5, 2002, until December 4, 2004. Reinstatement will be subject to adherence to the following stipulations;

1. Documented monthly attendance of Alcoholics Anonymous and/or Narcotics Anonymous meetings by Robert Hugill for twelve consecutive months ending December 4, 2004.

2. Robert Hugill will submit to six (6) random urinalysis tests, to be completed within twenty-four (24) hours of notification by OPP, under the supervision of a medical provider mutually agreed upon with OPP. If the result of any of these tests is positive for alcohol or drugs, Robert Hugill's teaching certificate will be immediately suspended.

3. Robert Hugill will have a alcohol and drug evaluation by an evaluator mutually agreed upon with OPP, which establishes his ability to remain drug and alcohol free, and will follow any recommendations made in the evaluation.

4. Robert Hugill will provide a written release which allows OPP to contact his evaluator, and to access the results of his evaluation.

5. Reinstatement shall also require submission of a new application, provided by OPP and having Robert Hugill's fingerprints checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP).
