COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Chad Maughan, that the Washington education certificate, No. 390553F, of Chad Maughan, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACT

1. Chad Maughan was issued a Washington State Educational Certificate No. 390553F on August 20, 2001. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Chad Maughan was employed by the North Thurston School District.
3. On July 14, 2003, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the North Thurston School District alleging a lack of good

moral character or personal fitness, and a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Chad Maughan.

4. Chad Maughan viewed inappropriate sites on his school district computer during the spring term of 2003.

5. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Chad Maughan and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington education certificate, No. 390553F, of Chad Maughan, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.

3. Chad Maughan has violated WAC 180-86 and 180-87.
