COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Carol Wilson, that the Washington education certificate, No. 216233G, of Carol Wilson, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING(S) OF FACT

1. Carol Wilson was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 216233G, on October 21, 1999. This certificate currently remains valid.
2. Carol Wilson was employed by the North Thurston School District as a substitute teacher, a classified employee.

3. On November 8, 1998, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the North Thurston School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Carol Wilson.

4. On November 1, 1999, Carol Wilson kicked a kindergarten child on the leg causing the wound to bleed.

5. On June 15, 2000, as a result of kicking the child, Carol Wilson entered a one-year Agreed Motion and Order of Stipulation and Continuance in her assault case in Thurston County District Court. Carol Wilson was required to complete an Anger Management Evaluation and any recommended treatment. She successfully completed the court ordered program on July 20, 2000.

6. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington education certificate.

CONCLUSION(S) OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Carol Wilson and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington education certificate, No. 216233G, of Carol Wilson, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.

3. Carol Wilson has violated WAC 180-87, WAC 180-86-013, WAC 180-86-014 and RCW 28A.410.090.

ORDER


THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered and agreed that the Washington education certificate, No. 216233G, of Carol Wilson, be suspended for a minimum of twenty-four (24) months from the date of entry of this Order.

Reinstatement shall require submission of a new application, provided by OPP and having Carol Wilson's fingerprints be checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP).




