AGREED ORDER
OF SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Daniel J. Yarr, that the Washington Education Certificate, No.343146G, of Daniel J. Yarr, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Daniel J. Yarr was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 343146G, on January 31, 1996. This certificate currently remains valid.
2. Daniel J. Yarr was employed by the Concrete School District.
3. On November 22, 2002, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from the Superintendent of the Concrete School District alleging a lack

of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 180-87, by Daniel J. Yarr.

4. Between August of 2001 to June 30, 2002, Daniel J. Yarr viewed pornographic websites on school district equipment.
5. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Daniel J. Yarr and over the subject matter of this action.
2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington Education Certificate, No. 343146G, of Daniel J. Yarr, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 180-86-070.

3. Daniel J. Yarr has violated WAC 180-87-050.


ORDER


