 OF SUSPENSION

COMES NOW the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, under the authority granted by the laws of the state of Washington, having reviewed the file of the above-referenced case, and having considered the entire evidence contained therein, does hereby stipulate by and between the Office of Professional Practices (OPP), Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Kyle Young, that the Washington Education Certificate, No. 393926A, of Kyle Young, shall be suspended, based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth below:

FINDING OF FACTS

1. Kyle Young was issued a Washington Education Certificate, No. 393926A, on January 8, 2001. That certificate currently remains valid.
2. Kyle Young was employed by the Mt. Adams School District.

3. On May 15, 2008, the Office of Professional Practices, within OSPI, received a complaint letter from Richard Foss, Interim Superintendent of the Mt. Adams School District School District alleging a lack of good moral character or personal fitness, or a violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 181-87, by Kyle Young.

4. During the 2007-2008 school year, Kyle Young used Mt. Adams School District computer equipment to access and view sexually explicit material.

5. ~~On May 8, 2008, Kyle Young was placed on administrative leave.~~

6. On May 9, 2008, Kyle Young resigned his employment with the ~~East Valley~~ ^{MT. Adams} School District.

7. Good moral character and personal fitness is a continuing requirement to maintain a Washington Education Certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. OSPI has jurisdiction over Kyle Young and over the subject matter of this action.

2. OSPI has shown by clear and convincing evidence that Washington Education Certificate, No. 393926A, of Kyle Young, should be suspended as provided for in WAC 181-86-070.

3. Kyle Young has violated WAC 181-87-060, 181-86-013, 181-86-014, and/or RCW 28A.410.090.

ORDER




Reinstatement shall require submission of a new application, provided by OPP and having Kyle Young's fingerprints be checked by both the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Washington State Patrol (WSP). Reinstatement shall be also contingent upon Kyle Young's fingerprint background check returning with no criminal convictions that are listed in WAC 181-86-013, RCW 28A.410.090, and/or any felony convictions.
