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1. OSPI claims system – can we get details on what that system is?  
No, our preference is we would like a new claims solution as a component of the system using a file transfer to our accounting system AFRS.
2. Will you accept this as a Cloud solution or hosted in a data center?  
Yes, the preference is to be hosted by the vendor and licensing where we can own.
3. Looking at the money available for this project. Is there a range of money that is allocated?  
No cap on the cost. We are using the solicitation to understand the cost. The estimated cost at this time is \$1.5M. OSPI had to receive permission for additional delegated authority for this amount. The question was brought forward to ensure that the costs would not exceed a budgeted amount.
4. Would OSPI provide sample grant applications (form packages)?  
Yes – files are too large – will be emailed to individual vendors that sent letter of intent.
5. Can we have a program list? Example of grants you want consolidated.  
Yes – form packages will be emailed to individual vendors that sent letter of intent..
6. Do you have a data model?  
Data model is very dynamic so it may not be helpful. Can provide a blank data model if requested.
7. Do you have a time to go live?  
Would like to pilot some districts by February of 2019 – one-year project. Would like to go live sooner if possible.
8. Requesting clarification on Functional Requirement 44.  
A system administrator must be able to configure a data-driven rules engine to support complex rate and budget calculations using decision tree or other hierarchical logic. We will send an example of our budget calculations table.
9. Requesting clarification on Functional Requirement 54.  
Ability for OSPI users to make payment calculations.
