Note to potential respondents:

This Addendum is intended to revise, clarify and become part of Informal Solicitation No. 2019-26, issued May 1, 2019.

QUESTION: I am interested in applying for the Regional Coordinator position but do not have criteria 6 – “Experience facilitating National Board candidates as part of an OSPI-approved support program in the newly revised assessment process.” Do you have any information on this so that I may apply in the future?

ANSWER: To become a National Board candidate facilitator, our state network has put in place a process to train NBCTs in working with adult learners under the current National Board assessment process. Cohorts are only approved by OSPI if the district or organization contracts trained facilitators. Training does not guarantee that an approved support provider will immediately bring you on to facilitate, as that is dependent on local need. However, it does give you the opportunity in future years if a position becomes available (you are only required to attend training once).

Facilitator training registration is currently open. I’m including information for both training events, which are co-located with WEA Jump Start:

June – Pasco
