Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium Request for Proposals (RFP):  
RFP SBAC-02

Note to potential respondents:

- This Addendum is intended to revise, clarify and become part of the *IT Readiness Tool for SBAC and PARCC* RFP (SBAC-02), issued May 20, 2011.
  - All amendments, addendums, and notifications will be posted on the OSPI Web site and released via the Washington Electronic Business Solution (WEBS) Web site.
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An error associated with consistent communication of specifications was recently identified. The following edits are intended to correct these errors.

Section 6.2. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS (SCORED)

Amend the opening sentence, “The Proposal to meet the Technical Requirements must contain a comprehensive description of services **for each of the four requirements** described in Section 2.” to read “The Proposal to meet the Technical Requirements must contain a comprehensive description of services **for each of the three requirements** described in Section 2.”

EXHIBIT G, RFP Evaluation Criteria and Rating System, Section A. – Application Development

Amend the first criteria, “Across all requirements, the proposal presents a coherent and comprehensive approach that integrates well across the four Technical Requirements.” to read “Across all requirements, the proposal presents a coherent and comprehensive approach that integrates well across the three Technical Requirements.”

**NOTE:** Bidders are to recognize that the first requirement – Readiness Tool – has 10 elements in fulfilling the RFP specifications, and that the other two requirements – the “sniffer” and hosting services, are optional items desired by SBAC, but not mandatory for the bid process.
