Attached is a listing of the 2010 calendar year excess general fund maintenance and operation levy authority for those school districts headquartered in your county. The amount shown represents the **maximum** amount that may be certified for collection in 2010 by or on behalf of the school district for maintenance and operation purposes, pursuant to RCW 84.52.0531.

School district levies are certified to the county legislative authority by the board of directors of first class school districts and by the appropriate educational service district (ESD) for second class school districts.

For school districts located in more than one county, the levy authority shown must be divided among the counties. Please note that the school districts listed are only those headquartered in your county.

It should be noted that when the levy rate is determined for school district maintenance and operation levies, the greater of one-half of the timber assessed valuation, or 80 percent of the 1983 timber roll, must be added to assessed valuations.
