While not required, OSPI recommends districts administer at least one additional Social Studies CBA in elementary, middle, and high school. The grade-level placements of OSPI Developed Assessments (CBAs) are recommendations and districts may choose to place CBAs at different grade levels within the same grade band. Districts may also create their own Social Studies CBAs. CBAs have not yet been aligned to the revised Social Studies Standards; this work is in progress.
