Discipline Dashboard for CEDARS Exclusion Data— Access for Authorized District Staff

<u>Access</u>: Some district staff already have access to data through a secure connection to the Tableau Server at OSPI, such as the Learning Assistance Program dashboard.

Access to these dashboards is controlled at the district level by the District Data Security Manager (DDSM). If you do not have access, contact your DDSM and request the role of "Tableau_SecureDataPortal_Student_Interactor." A list of DDSMs can be found here: https://eds.ospi.k12.wa.us/SecurityManagerList.aspx. *Please note:* Changes made will not be effective until the next day, so the user should wait 24 hours before logging in.

Once access is granted:

1. Log into the Education Data System (EDS). You can find a link at the bottom of any OSPI web page. www.k12.wa.us




- 2. Enter your user name and password to log in to EDS: https://eds.ospi.k12.wa.us/
- 3. Then, click on "View my applications."



4. Click on (select) "Tableau Server" from the applications list:



5. Select the Discipline Dashboard by clicking on the image labeled "Discipline Dashboard Security Filter" →




- 6. The first tab includes descriptions of the multiple dashboard views.
