Discipline Dashboard for CEDARS Exclusion Data— Access for Authorized District Staff

<u>Access</u>: Some district staff already have access to dashboards that use student data, such as the Learning Assistance Program Dashboard, through the Education Data System (EDS), which provides a secure connection to the Tableau Server at the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI).

Access to these dashboards is controlled at the district level by the District Data Security Manager (DDSM). If you do not have access, contact your DDSM and request the role of "Tableau_SecureDataPortal_Student_Interactor." A list of DDSMs can be found here: <u>https://eds.ospi.k12.wa.us/SecurityManagerList.aspx</u>. *Please note: Changes to access will not be effective until the next day, so the user should wait 24 hours before logging in.*
