





# What does 5030 require?

The written plan must:

(4) Establish an **annual** review and assessment **process** for the comprehensive school counseling **program** that includes building **administrators** and **stakeholders**.

# "Annual Process"


- "Annual" Occurs every school year around the same time
  - Timing recommend sometime between March-June (early enough that it can impact the district transition plan updates and be prioritized before end of year tasks become consuming; late enough that the CSCP has results to review)
  - Goal is continuous improvement not a "gotcha" or "one and done"
- "Process" a series of actions/steps is taken in order to achieve a particular end
  - Prioritized & protected from competing priorities (\*leadership move)
  - What systems might need **shifting** in order to prioritize this? What's in your sphere of influence?
  - Begin systemizing the sharing of CSCP program evaluation with the school board (begin making preparations to share with the board a few times per year)



# "Program"

"To achieve the best results for students, school counselors regularly assess their program to determine its **effectiveness**."

The CSCP is "designed with continuous assessment and improvement in mind."



# CSCP staff collect and analyze data to answer questions such as:

- Who participated in what activities through instruction, appraisal, advisement, and counseling?
- What ASCA Mindsets & Behaviors did students learn through participation in school counseling activities?
- How did learning affect students' attendance, behavior, and achievement?

# "Administrators" and "Stakeholders"

Who participates in the program review and assessment? .... Whoever your key partners are!

- At minimum, a <u>supervising administrator</u> & <u>all CSCP staff</u>
- Start small with just a few additional partners you trust and who will have thoughtful insights
- Consider using an existing structure like your school-based leadership team (BLT, admin leadership team, etc.)
- Intermediate/advanced programs: Consider developing a
   CSCP Advisory Council for this purpose if you haven't already

## **Recommended Data to Review and Assess**

In addition to the previous data on slide 14, also consider data related to **systems** and **programmatic goals** such as:

- Development of the CSCP TEAM collaboration structures, regular meetings with agendas, team cohesion, shared accountability, partnership between admins/CSCP staff, 2-way communication between CSCP staff and the district
- Development of processes that support CSCP staff efficiency and effectiveness - referral forms, processes for accessing CSCP staff, triage processes, flowcharts for which staff support which tasks and workstreams, crisis protocols, processes for who steps in when CSCP staff are not available, removal of non-counseling duties, lowering of ratios



# **Tools You Can Leverage**

- Ensure sure your team comes to **consensus** on which of these tools to use
- This year (in year 1), we invite district/ESD leads to support sites' autonomy in choosing the program assessment tool(s) they use this year
- Next year (in year 2), we encourage districts to consider aligning the program assessment tools districtwide, still allowing for some choice where appropriate







# Sharing the Results of Your Annual Program Assessment

After completing your annual program review and assessment, consider how you plan to **share your findings with key partners** in the school community

#### **Avenues to Share Results**

- Publicize a few highlights of your results in a regular school or counseling <u>newsletter/newspaper</u>
- Display a summary of counseling activities and outcomes on website
- Present your program results at the next school district <u>Board meeting</u>
- Prepare a report or present to the equivalent of the <u>Parent/Teacher</u> <u>Association/Organization</u>
- Provide as evidence or an 'artifact' during the <u>annual performance</u> evaluation discussion/process

#### Think Outside the Box!

- Submit to <u>state/national/district offices</u> seeking 'good news' stories
- Create an End of Year bulletin board or other visual display stating 'thanks for a great year!'
- Incorporate into planned <u>National</u>
   School Counseling Week activities
- Present a workshop session or poster session at state and national conferences
- Social media exchanges and blogs
- Present at an Advisory Council Meeting

# **CSCP Staff Evaluation**

- Not required by 5030 but a natural part of this system shift
- There is a variety of staff doing this work, some are part of professions/others not - bill is not intended to compromise anyone's professional identity
- We understand staff evals might be the next step in some districts while others may not be ready for this step yet (that's ok)
- OSPI, AWSP, Hatching Results, WA counselor educators, and others are information gathering
  - Landscape scans of high quality CSCP staff evaluation tools and processes (if you have examples of good ones, please send them to <a href="mailto:maria.muto@k12.wa.us">maria.muto@k12.wa.us</a>)
  - Researching other professionals' evaluation best practices
  - Considering that some CSCP staff doing this work aren't necessarily part of professions with evaluation standards


## ESAs: The Carpool Lane


