2017-2019 Reviewed HIV/Sexual Instructional Materials

Consistency with Washington State Requirements

The Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), in collaboration with the Washington Department of Health (DOH) and a panel of reviewers representing local districts and public health experts, conducts regular reviews of HIV prevention and sexual health instructional materials to assess their consistency with the AIDS Omnibus Act (<u>RCW</u> <u>28A.230.070</u>), the 2005 <u>Guidelines for Sexual Health Information and Disease Prevention</u> and the further requirements the Healthy Youth Act (HYA) (<u>RCW 28A.300.475</u>). Commonly used titles are reviewed, along with promising materials identified by districts and OSPI. A<u>review of sexual abuse prevention materials</u> was done in 2018 as part of OSPI's Erin's Law implementation.

The following list includes titles reviewed between 2017 and 2019, using instructional materials review tools that no longer reflect Washington legislative requirements. Districts that want to use titles on this list or that have not been reviewed by OSPI and DOH must use OSPI's up-to-date instructional materials review instruments to assess suitability for use. Medical accuracy reviews should be conducted by DOH or a panel of experts with relevant clinical/research expertise, in accordance with state law.

Titles labeled "full" curricula are generally comprehensive curricula that include lessons addressing a wide range of topics, intended to be taught over the course of a unit of instruction or several grades. Titles labeled "supplemental" are generally materials that address only one topic or theme or are intended for use to supplement one lesson. Titles including content on affirmative consent or bystander training are indicated.

All full reviews are available on OSPI's <u>Instructional Materials Review</u> <u>Reports and Tools webpage</u>, including contact information for publishers.

OSPI does not "approve," "endorse," or "recommend" curricula. Approval and adoption happen at the district level after district- or school-level reviews to ensure that materials are suitable for use in that community.

Elementary School (Grades K-3)

Note: <u>New requirements</u> set to take effect in 2022-23 for elementary schools will NOT require districts to provide sexuality content in grades K-3. Instruction for grades K-3 "must be <u>social emotional learning</u>."

Schools will not be required to use or adopt a curriculum in order to provide social emotional learning, though using an evidence-based program over time is recommended. Social and emotional learning is a process through which individuals build awareness and skills in managing emotions, setting goals, establishing relationships, and making responsible decisions that support success in school and in life.
