For: Washington state
Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction

GOAL: All Belong will partner with Washington non-public schools to support students who may have experienced learning loss or other educational challenges due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

SCOPE: All Belong offers services that advance inclusive education for students of all abilities through providing:

In person, two- to three-day visits at partner schools with an assigned Teacher Consultant. This time can be spent in observations, developing instructional plans, including curriculum development, for in-person, remote or hybrid learning, to address learning loss.

- **Virtual service meetings** to be scheduled throughout the school year with nonpublic schools' Academic Supports teams. Includes preparation and follow up regarding specific students or topics of conversation.

Membership access for all staff at partner schools to utilize All Belong intellectual property, custom forms, and attend all professional development webinars and inservices. Also includes administrative support to advance inclusive education at nonpublic schools.

Comprehensive educational consultations with an All Belong school psychologist, to be conducted via videoconferencing technology and addressing individual student needs.
