Specialty Endorsements

Eastern Washington University (EWU) plans to apply to PESB to approve a Specialty Endorsement in Social Emotional Learning. EWU would like to share their vision for the endorsement and seek guidance from the SEL Advisory Committee regarding the application. Currently, EWU offers graduate and undergraduate Social Emotional Learning for Educational Equity (SEL-EE) certificates and may provide data for a required pilot group. The application requires EWU to partner with other organizations. NEW ESD 101 has agreed to partner with EWU for the application. EWU is seeking additional universities to write letters of support indicating an interest in offering pathways for the SEL Specialty Endorsement.
