Levy rollbacks occur when a district collects less than voters have approved.

Local effort assistance (LEA) is state matching money paid on levies in districts with high tax rates due to low assessed valuations. Districts eligible to receive LEA money must pass a levy in order to receive LEA money. LEA began in 1989 and was only partially funded that year.
