Purpose: OSPI is repealing chapter 392-109 WAC because the rules are no longer applicable due to a change in statute. The Washington State Legislature passed HB 1974 (2022) moving the administration of elections for elected members of the State Board of Education to the Washington State School Directors' Association (WSSDA). As WSSDA is now responsible for the administration of these elections and establishing related procedures, the rules under chapter 392-109 WAC are no longer valid.
