Breakfast Meals for Kids Grant

The Washington State Legislature provides funding for annual competitive grants available to public school districts. Funds may be used to:

- ✓ Start a School Breakfast or other school meal program;
- ✓ Increase participation and/or quality in an established meal program;
- ✓ Or improve the equipment and facilities used in an established meal program.

All federal, state, and local procurement laws must be followed.

How to qualify for the grant:

- ✓ Be a Public school district, Charter School, or Tribal Compact School
- ✓ Sponsor a school meal program, this includes: School Breakfast Program (SBP), National School Lunch Program (NSLP)
- Your school(s) may prepare meals on-site, receive meals from another school that participates in a USDA Child Nutrition Program; or may contract with a food service management company

This funding may be used to improve or start the SBP or other school meal program by:

- ✓ Purchasing food service equipment.
- ✓ Providing staff training.
- ✓ Marketing your Program.
- ✓ Providing outreach to students, families, and school staff, including translation services.
- ✓ Improving efficiency, sanitation, or safety in the food service area.

Grant Evaluation:

Proposals from all school districts will be evaluated and ranked in iGrants (Form Package 383) by a committee established pursuant to <u>WAC 392-157-140</u>.



Grant Timeline & Details

- ✓ December 2023– Grant application opens in iGrants
- ✓ January 16, 2024– Grant Application closes in iGrants
- ✓ February 2024– Awardees notified
- ✓ April 30– Finalize purchases including delivery
- May 30– Submit supporting documents Including, but not limited to: Purchase orders, Delivery receipts, Invoices, Proof of
 - payment, Pictures of Equipment, Time and effort forms, Payroll summary reports, and travel documents
- ✓ June 30, 2024– All grant activities must be completed
